

"March for Life"



Since Roe v. Wade, over 62 million lives have been lost to legal abortion. In October 1973 a group of 30 pro-life leaders gathered in Washington D.C. to discuss how to commemorate the one-year anniversary of Roe v. Wade. The first March for Life took place in January 1974 to walk on Washington to lobby Congress to find a

legislative solution to the Supreme Court's decision. Realizing that congressional protection of the unborn was not on the horizon, it was decided that a March for Life would be held each year until Roe v. Wade is overturned. This year's March will take place on January 21, 2022 (Source Marchforlife.org).

The Parish of the Holy Spirit here in Keene has been holding a prayer service each year during the week of the March for Life at Saint Joseph's Cemetery in Keene at the site of the monument of the unborn. We will be gathering this year on Sunday January 16, 2022 at IPM at the cemetery for this year's prayer service. Following the service, adoration will take place and a rosary for life will be said at Saint Bernard's church. All are invited to attend.

As mentioned in our bulletin on December 12, 2021, Fr. Alan was scheduled to lead a group from our parish and Our Lady of Mercy Academy to this year's March for Life. The Diocese of Manchester, NH cancelled the trip this year due to COVID concerns. We had intended to make the trip on our own; however, after much prayer and more information about the COVID exposures, our trip was cancelled.

My wife Noreen and I were looking forward to participating in this year's March for Life and seeing all the young people from around the country who support the pro-life movement. We will pray for those who will attend the March this year and continue to pray for the protection of the unborn. A 9 day Novena for Life (January 19-27) can be found on the following website: https://www.respectlife.org.

The good news is that it appears that there is momentum in the U.S. to protect the unborn as seen recently by passage of several State laws and recent court rulings. Let us pray that these efforts continue.




