





## **Pastor's Corner**

Trouble has come to the communities of gentiles. The early Church's resolution is for Paul, Barnabas, Judas—who has the interesting surname Barsabbas, and Silas to go with a letter that should bring peace to the heart of the community. The inspiration for this letter has come from the Holy Spirit. Essentially, it is through the Holy Spirit that they will find peace. However, the meaning behind two of the disciples' names can help us see that human cooperation can be part of giving peace. Barnabas is understood as the "son of encouragement." Barsabbas is understood as the "son of the Sabbath". When someone becomes discouraged by lack of results in ministry, they will often not find peace. If encouragement comes, either by some help sent their way or simply through reassurance of the value of their work, then a sort of peace can return to them through simple human help. The resulting peace in the person could be understood as "child of encouragement." If on the other hand the lack of peace is due to exhaustion, then some well-deserved rest might be the answer. This newfound peace could be thought of as the "child of the Sabbath." In our Gospel reading for this weekend, a look back at the Last Supper, Jesus offers peace to his disciples. He makes the promise to them of sending the Holy Spirit. This Spirit will firmly establish peace in them and validate the faith they have been given. Jesus starts their instruction in peace and knowledge, and the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in Jesus' name, will complete it. The beauty of this kind of peace is like the beautiful city of God coming down from heaven. Ours is to serve in any way we can to help bring about this city of God, a city of peace.




