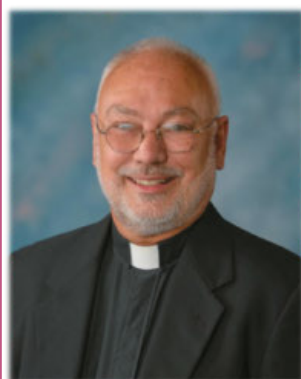

**St. Joan of Arc | May 30**

St. Joan of Arc (1412 – 1431) has had her story told throughout history through many books, movies and plays. She was born in the village of Domrémy, near the province of Lorraine, to a French peasant family. At a young age, she began to experience visions and voices, which were later identified to be of St. Michael, St. Catherine of Alexandria, and St. Margaret of Antioch. At the age of 13, all three saints told her that she was to drive the English from French territory, and that she must bring the Dauphin to Reims for his coronation. Trusting in God, she did as she was told.

During the Hundred Years War, St. Joan of Arc led French troops against the English and recaptured the cities of Orléans and Troyes. Captured near Compiègne the following year, she was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft, eventually being found guilty and burned at the stake in Rouen.

St. Joan of Arc was canonized by Pope Benedict XV on May 16, 1920, and is the patron saint of military members.

**Pastor's Corner**



The oneness that Jesus calls for in today's Gospel is one of "kind" and "substance". By "kind" I mean exactly what we see happening in the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles. We see that Stephen who is filled with the Holy Spirit has the same kind of responses to attacks upon himself as Jesus did. In verse 59 he cries out "Lord Jesus, receive my Spirit." This is the same kind of turning over of spirit as Jesus does in Luke 23:46 where he says: "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit." Then again Stephen has a like response to that of Jesus when in verse 60 he says: "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." This follows the pattern of Jesus in Luke 23:34 where Jesus says: "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do." As for "substance", this is found in the manner of proclaiming and revealing Jesus as Jesus himself revealed the Father by his death. Jesus has made God the Father known and has given this same ability to his followers. This is Jesus' prayer in this Gospel reading and it seems to have taken effect when we read the account of Stephen in the Acts of the Apostles. A missionary prayer echoed this in what was prayed and asked for by those working as disciples in mission. It says: "Draw us by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit into a greater zeal for the mission of making you known." As Pentecost Sunday approaches and we call upon the Holy Spirit to transform our lives, may we ask that we become like Jesus both in "kind" and "substance." Experiencing God "within us" is how we can become like Jesus and make him known to others.
