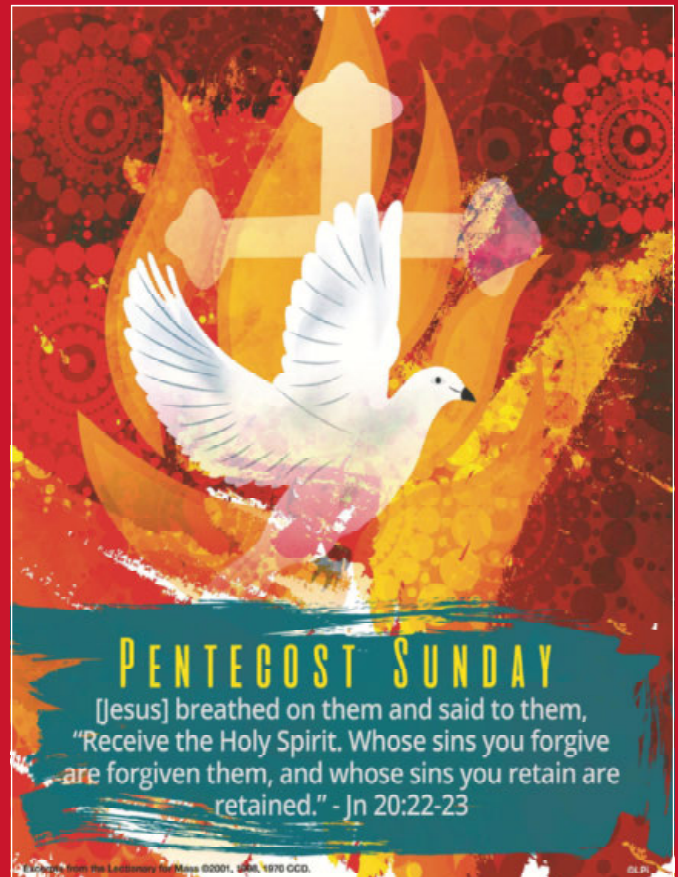

### Cardinal Classic Golf Tournament

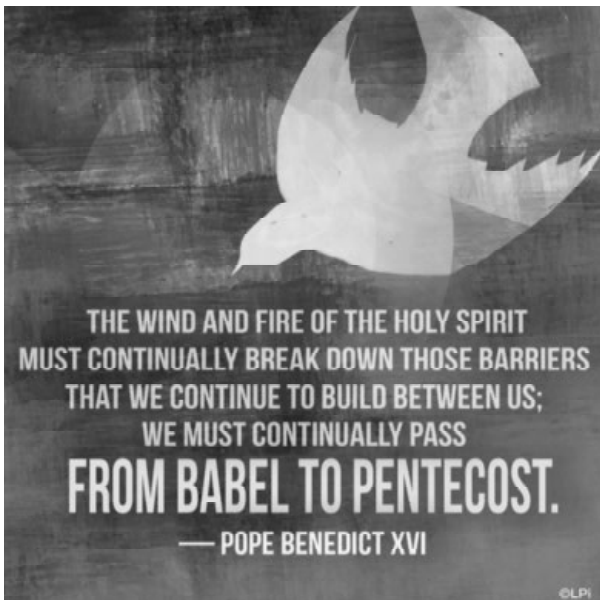


