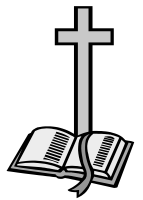
First 2025 Calendar Drawing

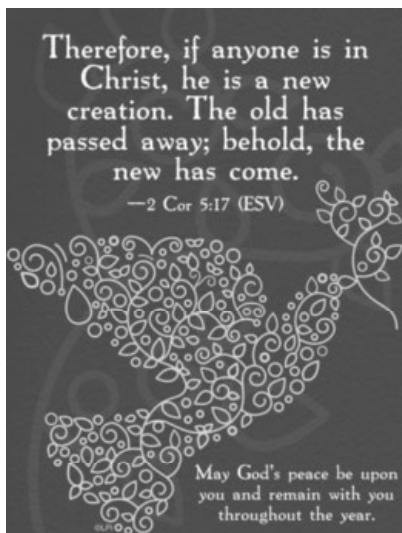
Perpetual Novena to Matt Talbot
