Third Sunday of Lent March 7, 2021



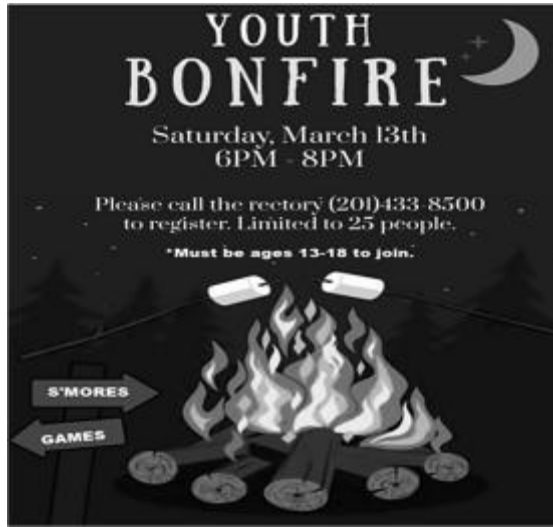
This week we are reminded in our first reading of the Ten Commandments. Every time I read them now, I think of the two tablets in front of our Church. These are the “fundamentals” of Christian living and it is nice that they are in prominent display in front of our church because we

need a reminder every once in a while of these fundamentals. The problem is that sometimes we read the commandments and feel that they are antiquated or outdated. Let us be reminded that God never goes out of style. Fashions, trends, ideologies, government systems, philosophies all go out of style. But, God’s Commandments are eternal truths that endure for all ages. Breaking God’s commandments affect us here on earth, and also eternally. This week, let’s go back to the basics and examine ourselves: Do I worship any false God’s? Maybe we don’t have statues that we worship, but maybe we get lost in the worship of material possessions, image, reputation, pride and vanity. Each of the commandments apply to a much broader aspect of life than how they seem at face value. Take time this week to think about the commandments and how they apply to us. For those commandments that we have lived well: keep going! For those commandments that we have broken, make a good confession and trust that God is merciful, just, and loving!

Esta semana se nos recuerda en nuestra primera lectura de los Diez Mandamientos. Cada vez que las leo ahora, pienso en las dos tablas frente a nuestra Iglesia. Estos son los “fundamentos” de la vida cristiana y es bueno que estén en una exhibición prominente frente a nuestra iglesia porque necesitamos un recordatorio de vez en cuando de estos fundamentos. El problema es que a veces leemos los mandamientos y sentimos que están anticuados o pasados de moda. Recordemos que Dios nunca pasa de moda. Las modas, las tendencias, las ideologías, los sistemas de gobierno, las filosofías pasan de moda. Pero los mandamientos de Dios son verdades eternas que perduran por todas las edades. El quebrantamiento de los mandamientos de Dios nos afecta aquí en la tierra y también eternamente. Esta semana, volvamos a lo básico y examinémonos a nosotros mismos: ¿Adoro a algún Dios falso? Tal vez no tengamos estatuas que adoremos, pero tal vez nos perdamos en la adoración de las posesiones materiales, la imagen, la reputación, el orgullo y la vanidad. Cada uno de los mandamientos se aplica a un aspecto mucho más amplio de la vida de lo que parece literalmente. Tómese un tiempo esta semana para pensar en los mandamientos y cómo se aplican a nosotros. Por esos mandamientos que hemos vivido bien: ¡sigue adelante! Por esos mandamientos que hemos quebrantado, haz una buena confesión y confía en que Dios es misericordioso, justo y amoroso.
