Palm Sunday

As with so many other things this year, our experience of Holy Week and Easter will be a bit different. As you noticed, there was no outdoor gathering today for the blessing of the palms. On Holy Thursday there will be no "washing of the feet." On Good Friday we will not kiss the cross, instead we will venerate the Cross by kneeling silently from our seats. Also on Good Friday; instead of our outdoor procession and youth group stations, we will be showing the movie, "the Passion of the Christ" in Church at 6:30pm. For the Easter Vigil we will gather in our seats to begin the ceremony instead of gathering outside around the Easter fire. The full Holy Week Schedule can be found in the announcement section of the bulletin. All liturgical services will be livestreamed via Facebook.

These small changes don't change the reality of what we celebrate. Lent, Holy Week and Easter are the most sacred times of year and nothing, not even disease, death, or social distance can change the redeeming work of Christ on the Cross.

Today we carry our palms in commemoration of Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. His triumph is not a worldly triumph of wealth and power. Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem is more of a

regular, every day, and "average Joe" type of triumph. It's the triumph of a man who knows what he needs to do in order to accomplish his mission. It is the triumph of every man, woman, and child faced with difficulties and burdens who trusts and hopes in God's strength to get them through it. Lastly, Jesus' triumph is His Passion. He took on suffering and death head on, and he conquered it. Today we prepare with Jesus who was getting ready for His battle with sin, rejection, pain, abuse, shame, and abandonment. So we lay our palms before Him and we hold on to our palms throughout the year to remind us of our union with Christ who conquered all things, even death itself, with faith in God. We, too, can conquer our daily battles with that same faith in God alone.



Como tantas otras cosas este año, nuestra experiencia de Semana Santa y Pascua será un poco diferente. Como notaron, hoy no hubo una reunión afuera para bendecir las palmas. El Jueves Santo no habrá "lavado de pies". El Viernes Santo no besaremos la cruz, sino que veneraremos la Cruz arrodillándonos en silencio desde nuestros asientos. También el Viernes Santo; en lugar de nuestra procesión y estaciones de grupos de jóvenes, estaremos proyectando la película "La Pasión de Cristo" en la Iglesia a las 6:30 pm. Para la Vigilia Pascual nos reuniremos en nuestros asientos para comenzar la ceremonia en lugar de reunirnos afuera alrededor del fuego de Pascua. El horario completo de Semana Santa se puede encontrar en la sección de anuncios del boletín. Todos los servicios litúrgicos se transmitirán en vivo a través de Facebook.

Estos pequeños cambios no cambian la realidad de lo que celebramos. Cuaresma, Semana Santa y Pascua son los tiempos más sagrados del año y nada, ni siquiera la enfermedad, la muerte o la distancia social puede cambiar la obra redentora de Cristo en la Cruz.

*Hoy llevamos nuestras palmas en conmemoración de la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén. Su triunfo no es un triunfo mundano de riqueza y poder. La entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén es más un triunfo regular y cotidiano en el sentido que es el triunfo de un hombre que sabe lo que necesita hacer para cumplir su misión. Es el triunfo de todo hombre, mujer y niño que se enfrenta a dificultades y cargas que confía y espera en la fuerza de Dios para superarlo. Por último, el triunfo de Jesús es su pasión. Asumió el sufrimiento y la muerte de frente, y lo conquistó. Hoy nos preparamos con Jesús que se estaba preparando para su batalla con el pecado, el rechazo, el dolor, el abuso, la vergüenza y el abandono. Así que ponemos nuestras palmas ante Él y nos aferramos a nuestras palmas durante todo el año para recordarnos nuestra unión con Cristo que conquistó todas las cosas, incluso la muerte misma, con fe en Dios. Nosotros también podemos conquistar nuestras batallas diarias con esa misma fe solo en Dios. Dios les bendiga,
