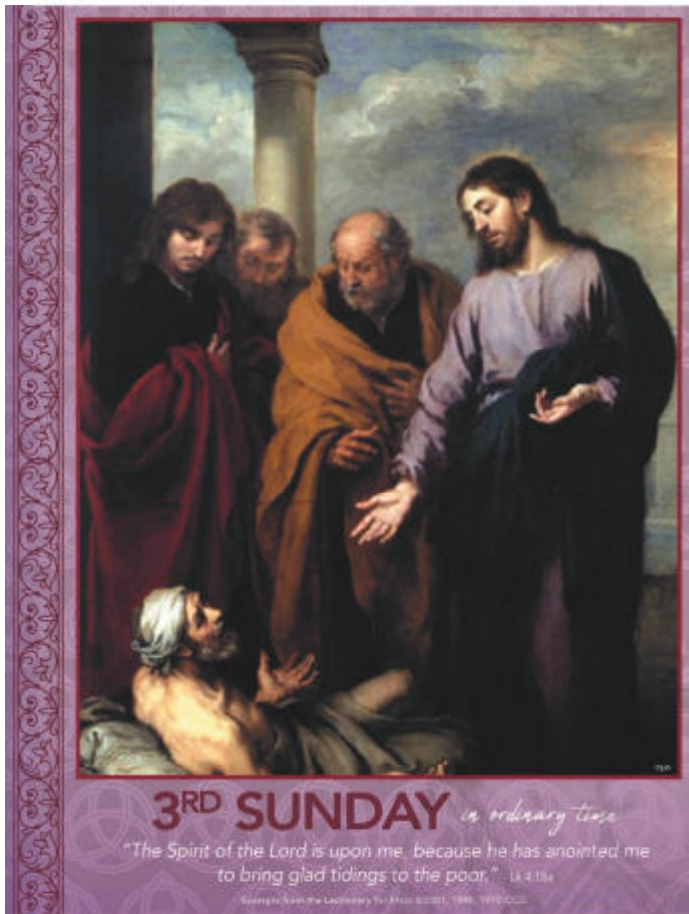

3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In 2019, Pope Francis declared the 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time (today) "Word of God Sunday." In his apostolic letter, "Aperuit Illis," the pope reminds us: "As Christians, we are a single people, making our pilgrim way through history, sustained by the Lord, present in our midst, who speaks to us and nourishes us. A day devoted to the Bible should not be seen as a yearly event but rather a year-long event, for we urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen Lord, who continues to speak his word and to break bread in the community of believers. For this reason, we need to develop a closer relationship with sacred Scripture; otherwise, our hearts will remain cold and our eyes shut, struck as we are by so many forms of blindness."

While there are many opportunities to grow in a deeper knowledge of Sacred Scripture, the most simple is picking it up and reading it. Today there are so many ways to read the Word of God. You can follow the daily Mass readings, you can follow Bible podcasts or audiobooks. You can listen to commentators on Youtube or Facebook. Here in the parish, our two missionaries are offering various times and dates for bible studies. Take advantage of these opportunities so that we can be a community that "makes our way through history, sustained by the Lord who speaks to us and nourishes us."

En 2019, el Papa Francisco declaró el 3er Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario (hoy) "Domingo de la Palabra de Dios". En su carta apostólica, "Aperuit Illis", el Papa nos recuerda:

"Como cristianos somos un solo pueblo que camina en la historia, fortalecido por la presencia del Señor en medio de nosotros que nos habla y nos nutre. El día dedicado a la Biblia no ha de ser "una vez al año", sino una vez para todo el año, porque nos urge la necesidad de tener familiaridad e intimidad con la Sagrada Escritura y con el Resucitado, que no cesa de partir la Palabra y el Pan en la comunidad de los creyentes. Para esto necesitamos entablar un constante trato de familiaridad con la Sagrada Escritura, si no el corazón queda frío y los ojos permanecen cerrados, afectados como estamos por innumerables formas de ceguera."

Si bien hay muchas oportunidades para crecer en un conocimiento más profundo de la Sagrada Escritura, la más simple es tomarla y leerla. Hoy en día hay tantas maneras de leer la Palabra de Dios. Puede seguir las lecturas diarias de la Misa, puede seguir podcasts bíblicos o audiolibros. Puedes escuchar a los comentaristas en Youtube o Facebook. Aquí en la parroquia, nuestros dos misioneros están ofreciendo varios horarios y fechas para estudios bíblicos. Aprovecha estas oportunidades para que podamos ser una comunidad que "se abre paso en la historia, sostenida por el Señor que nos habla y nos nutre".
