EUCHARIST OUTSIDE OF MASS

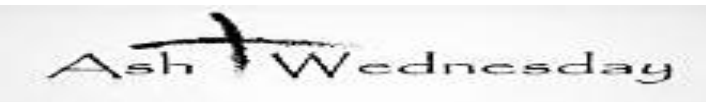


Distribution of the Eucharist for those who are unable to or who should not attend Mass is:
