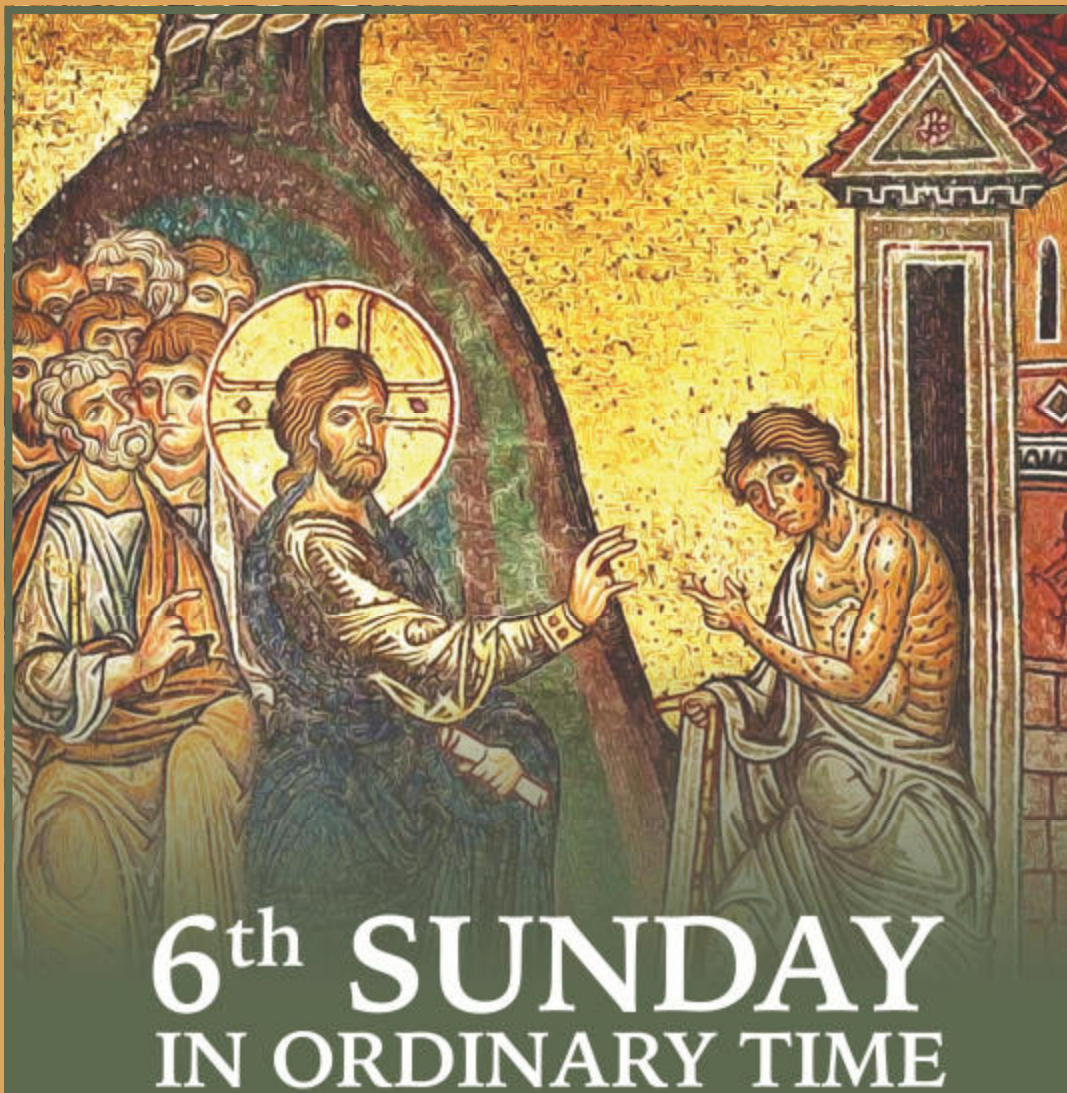

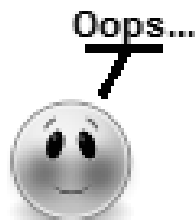


SPAGHETTI SUPPER ALTERNATIVE
