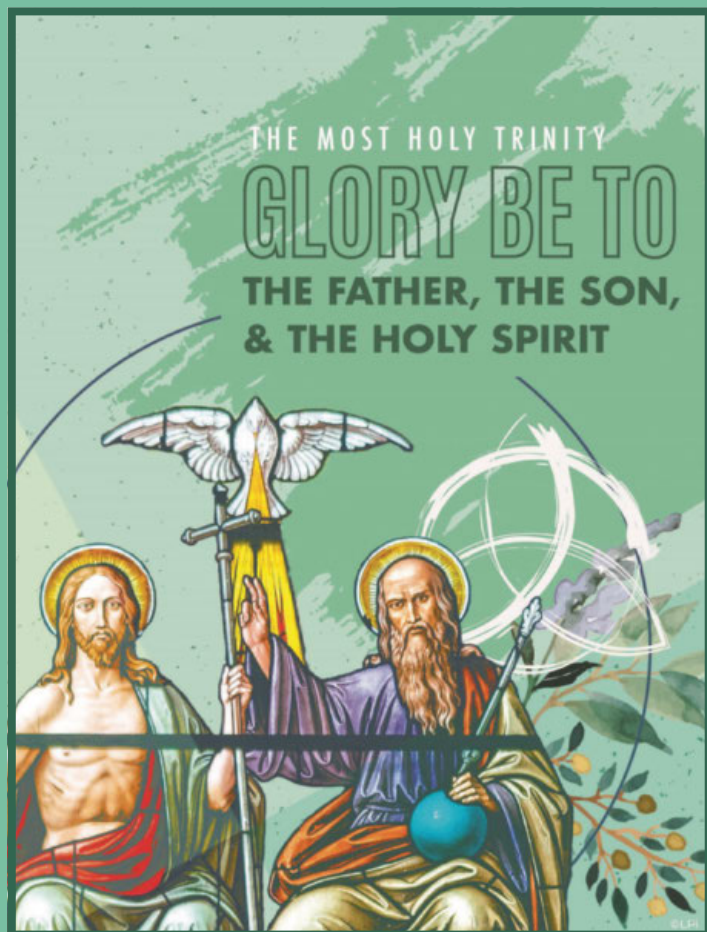

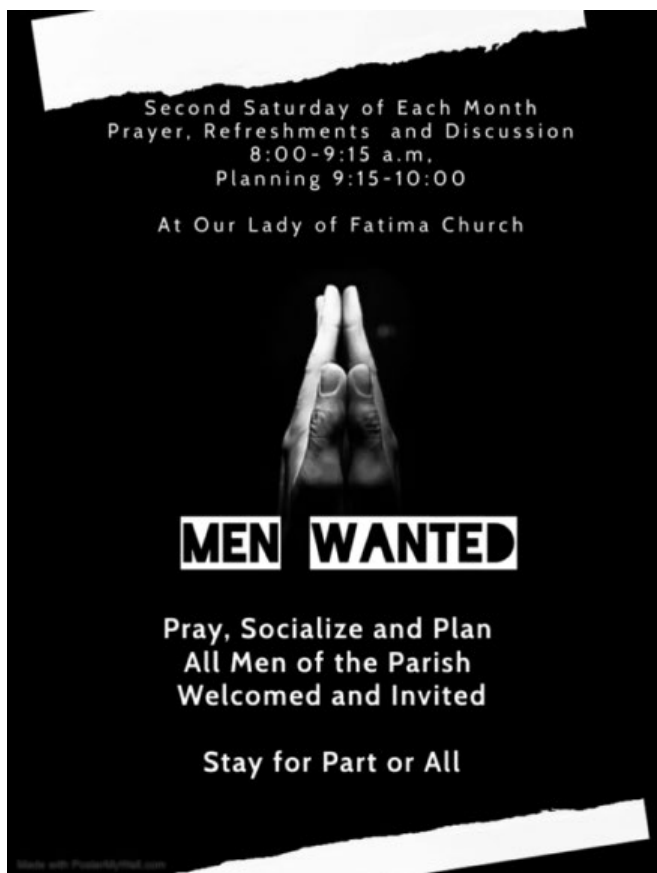
TAKE FIVE

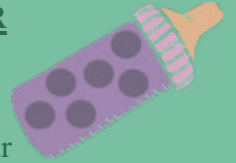
