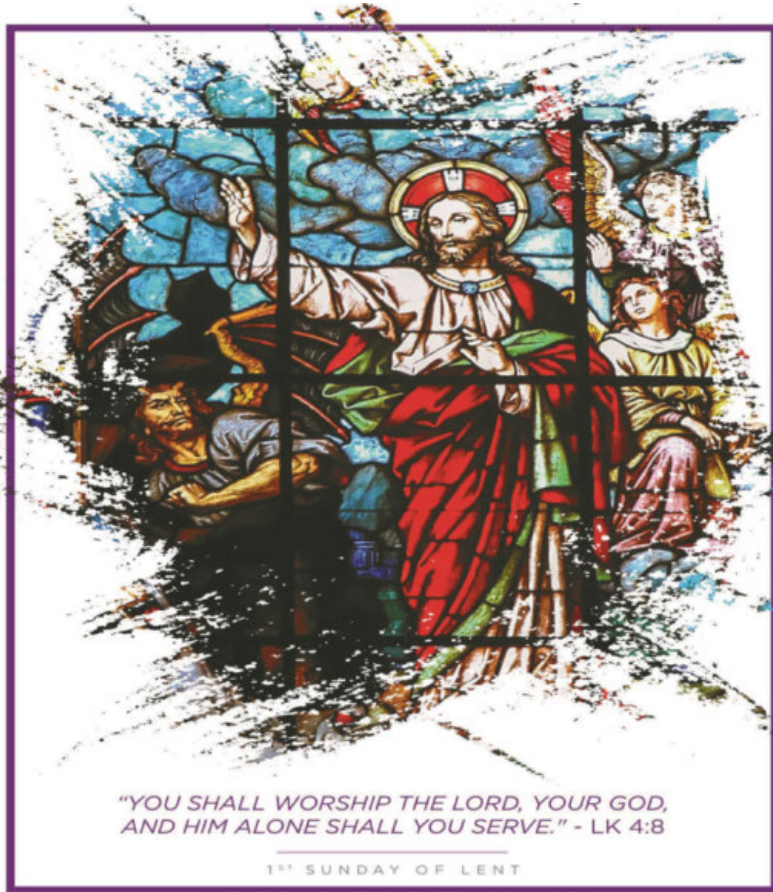

Week One | Restore: Lent with Sr. Miriam James Heidland, SOLT

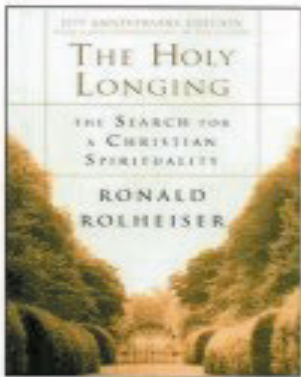
