Catholic Charities NH Online Dementia Support Group



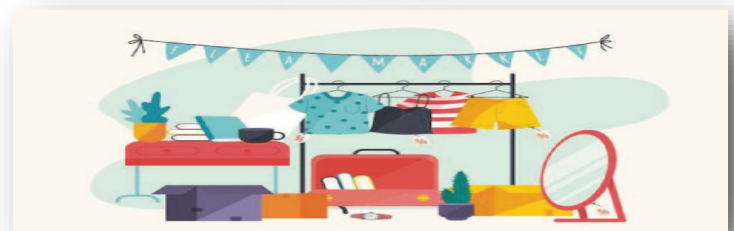
