Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

This weekend begins the Year of Grace 2022! Calendar years begin January 1st; fiscal years begin July 1st; academic years begin (usually) in September. But the liturgical year begins with the First Sunday of Advent, which we celebrate this weekend.

Advent is a time of spiritual preparation for the coming of Christ. In fact, the word “advent” comes from the Latin *adventus*, which means “arrival.” While the imagery revolves around preparation for Christmas, in fact, we’re preparing for Christ’s *second* coming; He’s not going to be born again in Bethlehem, but He *has* promised that He will return as Lord and Savior, as Judge of the living and the dead. Advent encourages us to reflect on that, so that when He comes, He might find us ready.

While the pre-vaccine pandemic prevented us from observing Advent in our customary way last year, I’m happy to say that this year, we’re able to bring back some cherished activities:

This weekend, our Religious Education Ministry will host an Advent Wreath Making Event at Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School immediately following the 11:00 Mass on Sunday. Participants will receive all the materials needed to make their wreaths; refreshments will also be provided. \$15 donation per family is requested.

On Monday evening, 6 December, our parish will host an Advent Reconciliation Service. The service begins at 6:00 PM.

On the Third Sunday of Advent, traditionally known as Gaudete Sunday, we will observe the Roman custom of “*The Blessing of the Bambinelli*.” “Bambinelli” is an Italian word for “infants,” and in this context refers specifically to the Christ-child figures that will be used in Nativity scenes in churches and homes. At each Mass that weekend (11/12 December), you’re invited to bring the Christ-child figurine from your crèche to Mass; at the end of Mass, I will bless them for you. In 2009, then-Pope Benedict spoke of this blessing in poignant terms: “The blessing of the ‘Bambinelli’ reminds us that the crib is a school of life where we can learn the secret of true joy. This does not consist in having many things but in feeling loved by the Lord, in giving oneself as a gift for others and in loving one another. Let us look at the crib. Our Lady and St. Joseph do not seem to be a very fortunate family; their first child was born in the midst of great hardship; yet they are full of deep joy, because they love each other, they help each other and, especially, they are certain that God, who made himself present in the little Jesus, is at work in their story.”

On Sunday, 12 December, St. John Neumann Catholic Church will host our *Tenth Annual Festival of Lessons and Carols* at 3:00 PM. This program of sacred and popular Advent music combined with the prayerful reading of appropriate Scriptures and time for reflection gives us the perfect opportunity to sit peacefully with the Lord and reflect on the great Mystery we’re preparing to celebrate. As was the case last year, there will be no “in-person” attendance; the event will be livestreamed and will be left on our YouTube page so that you can enjoy it throughout the Christmas season.

Mass will be celebrated on Christmas Eve (Friday, 24 December) at 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM and on Christmas morning (Saturday, 25 December) at 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM.

May God bless you, now and always!


