



Santos Inocentes, los niños mencionados en San Mateo, 16-18: "Herodes al percibir que fue engañado por los sabios, estaba muy enojado; y el envío mató a todos los niños varones que estaban en Belén, y en todas las fronteras de la misma, desde los dos años de edad y menos, de acuerdo con el tiempo que había preguntado diligentemente a los sabios. Entonces se cumplió lo que fue hablado por jeremías el profeta, diciendo: Se oyó una voz en Rama, lamentación y gran luto; Raquel lamentando a sus hijos, y no sería consolada, porque no lo son". La liturgia griega afirma que Herodes mató a 14.000 niños, los sirios hablan de 64.000, muchos autores medievales de 144.000. Esta cruel hazaña de Herodes no es mencionada por el historiador judío Flavio Josefo, aunque relata un buen número de atrocidades cometidas por el rey durante los últimos años de su reinado. El número de estos niños era tan pequeño que este crimen parecía insignificante entre las otras fechorías de Herodes. Macrobio relata que cuando Augusto escuchó que entre los niños de dos años y bajo el propio hijo de Herodes también había sido masacrado, dijo: "Es mejor ser el cerdo de Herodes, que su hijo", aludiendo a la ley judía de no comer, y en consecuencia no matar, cerdos. Es imposible determinar el día o el año de la muerte de los Santos Inocentes, ya que la cronología del nacimiento de Cristo y los eventos bíblicos posteriores es muy incierta. Todo lo que sabemos es que los bebés fueron sacrificados dentro de los dos años siguientes a la aparición de la estrella a los Reyes Magos. La Iglesia venera a estos niños como mártires (flores martyrum); son los primeros brotes de la Iglesia asesinados por la helada de la persecución; murieron no sólo por Cristo, sino en su lugar. En relación con ellos, el Apóstol recuerda las palabras del profeta Jeremías hablando del lamento de Raquel. En Rama se encuentra la tumba de Raquel, representante de los antepasados de Israel. Allí los restos de la nación fueron reunidos para ser llevados al cautiverio. Así como Raquel, después de la caída de Jerusalén, de su tumba lloró por los hijos de Efraín, así ahora llora de nuevo por los hombres hijos de Belén. de Jerusalén recibe su eminent finalización al ver la caída de su pueblo, iniciada por la matanza de sus hijos y el destierro del Mesías. En Belén la fiesta es un día santo de obligación. El color litúrgico de la Iglesia Romana es púrpura, no rojo, porque estos niños fueron martirizados en un momento en que no podían alcanzar la visión beatífica. Pero de compasión, por así decirlo, hacia las madres lloronas de Belén, la Iglesia omite en la Misa tanto la Gloria como el Aleluya.

Almighty God, We stand before you in supplication, asking Your Divine mercy and protection, to envelop with Your invincible armor, our loved ones in all branches of the service. Give them courage and strength against all enemies, both spiritual and physical, and hasten their safe journey, back to their homes and families. If it be Your Holy Will that they be gathered to Your bosom, with the eternal vanguard of the saints, let their journey to Your everlasting arms be swift and painless, where they may stand in honor and glory, praising You for all eternity.



Holy Innocents, the children mentioned in St. Matthew, 16-18: "Herod perceiving that he was deluded by the wise men, was exceeding angry; and sending killed all the men children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the borders thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently inquired of the wise men. Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremias the prophet, saying: A voice in Rama was heard, lamentation and great mourning; Rachel bewailing her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not." The Greek liturgy asserts that Herod killed 14,000 boys, the Syrians speak of 64,000, many medieval authors of 144,000. This cruel deed of Herod is not mentioned by the Jewish historian Flavius Josephus although he relates quite a number of atrocities committed by the king during the last years of his reign. The number of these children was so small that this crime appeared insignificant amongst the other misdeeds of Herod. Macrobius relates that when Augustus heard that amongst the boys of two years and under Herod 's own son also had been massacred, he said: "It is better to be Herod 's hog, than his son," alluding to the Jewish law of not eating, and consequently not killing, swine. It is impossible to determine the day or the year of the death of the Holy Innocents, since the chronology of the birth of Christ and the subsequent Biblical events is most uncertain. All we know is that the infants were slaughtered within two years following the apparition of the star to the Wise Men. The Church venerates these children as martyrs (flores martyrum); they are the first buds of the Church killed by the frost of persecution; they died not only for Christ, but in his stead. In connection with them the Apostle recalls the words of the Prophet Jeremias speaking of the lamentation of Rachel. At Rama is the tomb of Rachel, representative of the ancestresses of Israel. There the remnants of the nation were gathered to be led into captivity. As Rachel, after the fall of Jerusalem, from her tomb wept for the sons of Ephraim, so she now weeps again for the men children of Bethlehem. of Jerusalem receives its eminent completion at the sight of the downfall of her people, ushered in by the slaughter of her children and the banishment of the Messias. At Bethlehem the feast is a Holy Day of obligation. The liturgical color of the Roman Church is purple, not red, because these children were martyred at a time when they could not attain the beatific vision. But of compassion, as it were, towards the weeping mothers of Bethlehem, the Church omits at Mass both the Gloria and Alleluia
