

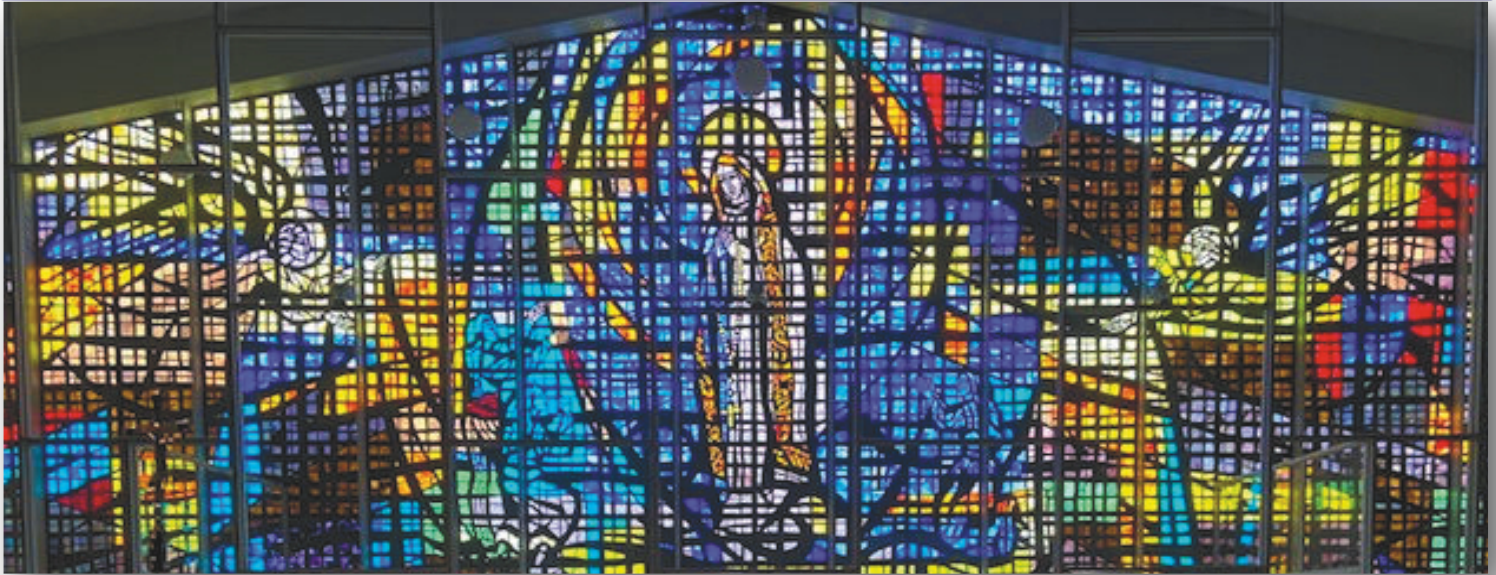

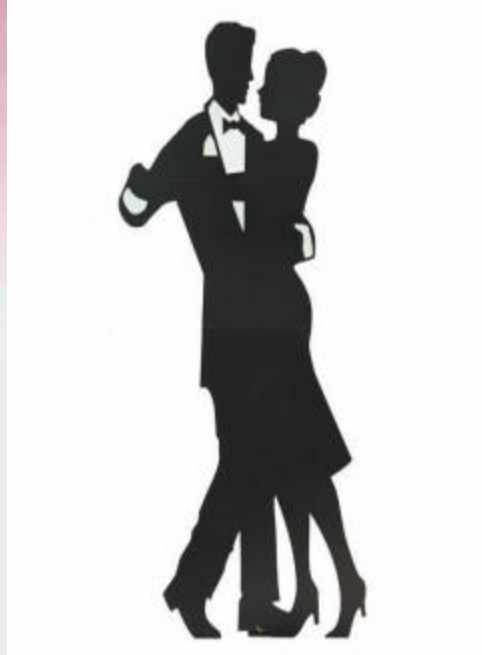

Elizabeth Ann Bayley Seton fue la primera nativa americana en ser canonizada por la Iglesia Católica. Elizabeth creció en la clase alta de la sociedad neoyorquina. A pesar de su origen, Elizabeth fue tranquila, y simple. A medida que crecía un poco, la Biblia se convertía en su continua instrucción, apoyo y consuelo. En 1794,

Elizabeth se casó con el joven y rico William Seton, de quien estaba profundamente enamorada. Elizabeth escribió en su diario al primer otoño: "Mi propia casa a los veinte años, el mundo, eso y el cielo también, bastante imposible". En cuatro años, el padre de William murió, dejando a la joven pareja a cargo de los siete medios hermanos y hermanas de William, así como del negocio de importación de la familia. Tanto el negocio como la salud de William fracasaron. Finalmente se vio obligado a declararse en bancarrota y, en un último intento de salvar la salud de William, los Seton navegaron hacia Italia. William murió de tuberculosis mientras estaba en Italia. El único consuelo de Isabel fue que había despertado recientemente a las cosas de Dios. Las muchas separaciones forzadas de seres queridos sirvieron para atraer el corazón de Isabel a Dios. En Italia, Elizabeth cautivó a todos por su amabilidad, paciencia, buen sentido, ingenio y cortesía. Durante este tiempo, Isabel se interesó en la fe católica. El deseo de Isabel por el Pan de Vida era ser una fuerza fuerte que la llevara a la Iglesia Católica. Habiendo perdido a su madre a una edad temprana, Isabel sintió un gran consuelo en la idea de que la Santísima Virgen era verdaderamente su madre. Le pidió a la Santísima Virgen que la guiara a la Verdadera Fe y se unió oficialmente a la Iglesia Católica en 1805. Fue entonces cuando Seton, y otras dos mujeres jóvenes que la ayudaron en su trabajo, comenzaron los planes para una hermandad. Establecieron la primera escuela católica gratuita en América. Cuando la joven comunidad adoptó su regla, hicieron provisiones para que Elizabeth continuara criando a sus hijos. El 25 de marzo de 1809, Elizabeth Seton pronunció sus votos de pobreza, castidad y obediencia, vinculantes durante un año. Desde ese momento se llamó Madre Seton. La Madre Seton se afligió de tuberculosis, pero continuó guiando a sus hijos. Hoy en día, seis grupos de hermanas pueden rastrear sus orígenes hasta la fundación inicial de la Madre Seton. La oración favorita de Seton era el Salmo 23 y desarrolló una profunda devoción a la Eucaristía, la Sagrada Escritura y la Virgen María. La Madre Seton murió en 1821 a la edad de 46 años, solo dieciséis años después de convertirse al catolicismo. Fue beatificada por el Papa Juan XXIII el 17 de marzo de 1963 y canonizada el 14 de septiembre de 1975 por el Papa Pablo VI.

Almighty God, We stand before you in supplication, asking Your Divine mercy and protection, to envelop with Your invincible armor, our loved ones in all branches of the service. Give them courage and strength against all enemies, both spiritual and physical, and hasten their safe journey, back to their homes and families. If it be Your Holy Will that they be gathered to Your bosom, with the eternal vanguard of the saints, let their journey to Your everlasting arms be swift and painless, where they may stand in honor and glory, praising You for all eternity.



Elizabeth Ann Bayley Seton was the first native born American to be canonized by the Catholic Church. Elizabeth grew up in the upper class of New York society. In spite of her high society background, Elizabeth's early life was quiet, simple. As she grew a little older, the Bible was to become her continual instruction, support and comfort. -In 1794, Elizabeth married the wealthy young William Seton, with whom she was deeply in love. Elizabeth wrote in her diary at first autumn, "My own home at twenty-the world-that and heaven too-quite impossible." This time of Elizabeth's life was to be a brief moment of earthly happiness. Within four years, William's father died, leaving the young couple in charge of William's seven half brothers and sisters, as well as the family's importing business. Both William's business and health failed. He was finally forced to file bankruptcy and, in a final attempt to save William's health, the Setons sailed for Italy. Unfortunately, William died of tuberculosis while in Italy. Elizabeth's one consolation was that he had recently awakened to the things of God. The many enforced separations of dear ones by death and distance served to draw Elizabeth's heart to God. In Italy, Elizabeth captivated everyone by her kindness, patience, good sense, wit, and courtesy. During this time Elizabeth became interested in the Catholic Faith and, over a period of months, her Italian friends guided her in Catholic instruction. Elizabeth's desire for the Bread of Life was to be a strong force leading her to the Catholic Church. Having lost her mother at an early age, Elizabeth felt great comfort in the idea that the Blessed Virgin was truly her mother. She asked the Blessed Virgin to guide her to the True Faith and officially joined the Catholic Church in 1805. It was then Seton, and two other young women who helped her in her work, began plans for a Sisterhood. They established the first free Catholic school in America. When the young community adopted their rule, they made provisions for Elizabeth to continue raising her children. On March 25, 1809, Elizabeth Seton pronounced her vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, binding for one year. From that time she was called Mother Seton. Mother Seton became afflicted with tuberculosis, but continued to guide her children. By 1818, in addition to their first school, the sisters had established two orphanages and another school. Today, six groups of sisters can trace their origins to Mother Seton's initial foundation. Seton's favorite prayer was the 23rd Psalm and she developed a deep devotion to the Eucharist, Sacred Scripture, and the Virgin Mary. Mother Seton died in 1821 at the age of 46, only sixteen years after becoming a Catholic. She was beatified by Pope John XXIII on March 17, 1963 and was canonized on September 14, 1975 by Pope Paul VI.
