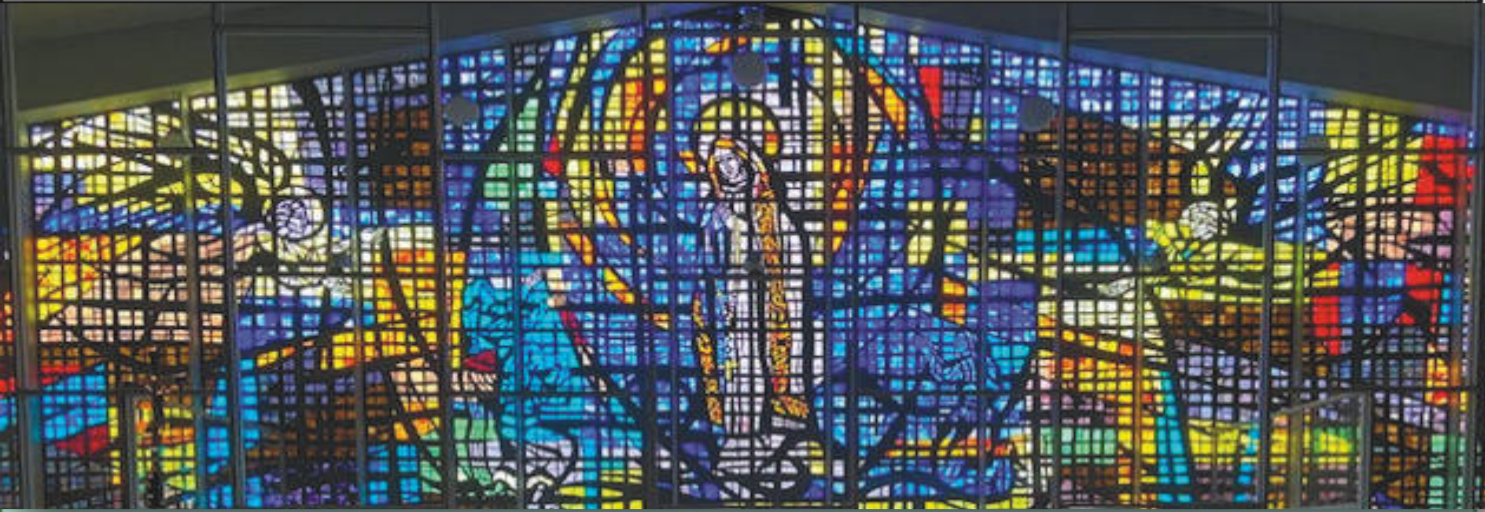

Santa Inés de Roma nació en el año 291 d.C. y se crió en una familia cristiana. Agnes era muy hermosa y pertenecía a una familia adinerada. Su mano en el matrimonio era muy buscada, y tenía muchos hombres de alto rango persiguiéndola. Sin embargo, Inés hizo una promesa a Dios de nunca manchar su pureza. ¡Su amor por el Señor era grande y odiaba el pecado incluso más que la muerte! Cada vez que un hombre deseaba casarse con Inés, ella siempre decía: "Jesucristo es mi único Esposo". Según la leyenda, los jóvenes a los que rechazó se enojaron e insultaron tanto por su devoción a Dios y pureza que comenzaron a presentar su nombre a las autoridades como seguidor cristiano. En un incidente, Procop, el hijo del Gobernador, se enojó mucho cuando ella lo rechazó. Trató de ganarla para su esposa con ricos regalos y promesas, pero la hermosa joven seguía diciendo: "Ya estoy prometido al Señor del Universo. ¡Él es más espléndido que el sol y las estrellas, y ha dicho que nunca me dejará!" Con gran enojo, Procop la acusó de ser cristiana y la llevó a su padre. El gobernador le prometió a Inés maravillosos regalos si ella solo negaba a Dios, pero Inés se negó. Trató de cambiar de opinión poniéndola encadenada, pero su hermoso rostro brillaba de alegría. Luego la envió a un lugar de pecado, pero un ángel la protegió. Por fin, fue condenada a muerte. No prestó atención a aquellos que le rogaron que se salvara. "Ofendería a mi cónyuge", dijo, "si tratara de complacerte. ¡Él me eligió primero y me tendrá!" En otras versiones, de Inés responsabilizan al prefecto Sempronio de su martirio. Se dice que condenó a la joven a ser arrastrada por las calles desnuda. Algunas versiones de la leyenda afirman que el cabello de Agnes creció instantáneamente para cubrir todo su cuerpo y todos los hombres que intentaron violarla quedaron inmediatamente ciegos. Las historias continúan explicando que otro hombre presidió el juicio de Inés. El nuevo hombre sentenció a Agnes a muerte. Al principio, Agnes estaba atada a una estaca, pero o la madera no ardía o las llamas se separaban de ella. Esto llevó a un oficial a desenvainar su espada y decapitar a la niña. Se cree que su sangre, que se derramó al estadio, fue empapada con telas por los cristianos. Murió virgen-mártir a la edad de 12 o 13 años el 21 de enero de 304. Agnes fue enterrada junto a la Via Nomentana en Roma. Sus huesos se conservan actualmente debajo del altar mayor en la iglesia de Sant'Angese fuori que fue construida sobre la catacumba que sostenía su tumba. Su cráneo se conserva en la iglesia de Sant'Agnese in Agone en la Piazza Navona de Roma.

St. Agnes of Rome was born in 291 AD and raised in a Christian family. Agnes was very beautiful and belonged to a wealthy family. Her hand in marriage was highly sought after, and she had many high ranking men chasing after her. However, Agnes made a promise to God never to stain her purity. Her love for the Lord was great and she hated sin even more than death! Whenever a man wished to marry Agnes, she would always say, "Jesus Christ is my only Spouse." According to legend, the young men she turned away became so angry and insulted by her devotion to God and purity that they began to submit her name to authorities as a Christian follower. In one incident, Procop, the Governor's son, became very angry when she refused him. He tried to win her for his wife with rich gifts and promises, but the beautiful young girl kept saying, "I am already promised to the Lord of the Universe. He is more splendid than the sun and the stars, and He has said He will never leave me!" In great anger, Procop accused her of being a Christian and brought her to his father, the Governor. The Governor promised Agnes wonderful gifts if she would only deny God, but Agnes refused. He tried to change her mind by putting her in chains, but her lovely face shone with joy. Next he sent her to a place of sin, but an Angel protected her. At last, she was condemned to death. Even the pagans cried to see such a young and beautiful girl going to death. Yet, Agnes was as happy as a bride on her wedding day. She did not pay attention to those who begged her to save herself. "I would offend my Spouse," she said, "if I were to try to please you. He chose me first and He shall have me!" Other accounts of Agnes' life hold the Prefect Sempronius responsible for her martyrdom. It is said he condemned the young girl to be dragged through the streets naked. Some versions of the legend state that Agnes' hair grew instantly to cover her entire body and all the men who attempted to rape the beautiful virgin were immediately struck blind. The stories go on to explain that another man presided over Agnes' trial after Sempronius excused himself. The new man sentenced Agnes to death. At first, Agnes was tied to a stake, but either the wood would not burn or the flames parted away from her. This prompted an officer to draw his sword and behead the girl. It is believed that her blood, which poured out to the stadium, was soaked up with cloths by Christians. She died a virgin-martyr at the age of 12 or 13 on 21 January 304. Agnes was buried beside the Via Nomentana in Rome. Her bones are currently conserved beneath the high altar in the church of Sant'Angese fuori le mura in Rome, which was built over the catacomb that held her tomb. Her skull is preserved in the church of Sant'Agnese in Agone in Rome's Piazza Navona.
