

## A Christmas Card Psalm

O you who showered sacred stars  
on the tiny town of Bethlehem,  
I thank you for guiding artists' brushes  
to create cards of beauty,  
bursting with blessings  
and filled with love and greetings from friends.

I lift up my heart in gratitude  
for these beautiful yearly bridges  
that bind us together in love,  
we who are often too busy  
for keeping up with friendship's needs.

My cards of Christmas past are now previous relics,  
and like the bones of saints  
they hold great power,  
and so I hate to bury them  
or see them burn.

Opened Christmas cards  
hum to me the hymn of love  
and teach me the sacrament of correspondence.  
Tie about the finger of my mind, Beloved One,  
a reminder that without reminders  
friendship fades from the failure  
to express words of love and appreciation  
to one another.

May these wondrous days of Christmas  
inspire me to celebrate  
the un-holidays of the year,  
the feasts of no-occasions,  
with love notes to friends who are far away.

Sacred season of the days of Christmas,  
gift me with the power to stop the clock,  
and live in the moment,  
so as to keep God alive within the world.  
For if God is love, then God may be found  
in the mystery of love exchanged.  
May I be a holy messenger of that mystery.

## Scripture Insights

On this Feast of the Epiphany, on which we celebrate the manifestation of God among all peoples, we hear once again rousing words from the Book of Isaiah. Note that in our reading the text is addressed to Jerusalem, the holy city, not to either a prophet or the people. While the word *Jerusalem* does not appear in the Hebrew text, it would seem that the editors of the lectionary wanted to make clear to the listeners of this proclamation that the words are, indeed, addressed to the holy city. Commentators agree that this portion of Isaiah focuses on the role of Jerusalem, the soon-to-be-restored city, where God's glory will be made manifest.

The first two chapters of Matthew's Gospel account are commonly referred to as the infancy narrative, and this material is often divided into several sections. Today's verses are frequently identified as "the adoration of the Magi." Another element may be important to note. The word *Bethlehem*, the place of Jesus' birth, appears four times in these twelve verses. Might we consider this town, this earthly place, a specific location at a given time in human history, where Jesus, son of David and Son of God, is made manifest in human flesh? It is because of this mystery of the Incarnation that the author of the Letter to the Ephesians could write of the Spirit "that the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise of Christ Jesus through the gospel.

- ◆ Reflect on the ways that God has been revealed to you.
- ◆ Today's Responsorial Psalm presents us with the depiction of an ideal king, a king who "rescues the poor when they cry out." What is your responsibility in helping to bring about such a world where justice and compassion reign?
- ◆ How has your image of Jesus coming into the world changed since your childhood? What does Christmas mean to you today?


