

March for Life Plenary Indulgence Granted: By virtue of the faculties given by the Supreme Pontiff, Francis, the Pope by Divine Providence, the Apostolic Penitentiary freely imparts a plenary Indulgence to be obtained under the usual conditions (sacramental Confession, eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff) by the Christian faithful who take part in the sacred celebrations of the annual event that is called "March for Life," which will be carried out on the 20th & 21st days of January 2022 throughout the Archdiocese of Washington (especially in the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary and in the Capital One Arena. 
