But the continued decline is hurting us.

Although we do not hold a bazaar or festival anymore at either church (mainly due to lack of volunteers) we are trying to raise funds in simpler ways to make it easier on all. Right now, at Gate of Heaven, the Annual Mega Raffle is going on. At Our Lady of Victory we have just sent out our Special Summer Collection envelopes and we are in the planning stages for our annual Golf Tournament and Basket Raffle. Gate of Heaven will be holding its Meatloaf Dinner and Basket Raffle in the Fall.

All these fundraisers may seem trivial to some, but they are vital to our survival as parishes. Please pray over what you can do to help us this year.

2024. 
