

Administrator's Notes

Praised be Jesus Christ, now and forever! Believe it or not, summer is officially over, and the weather is beginning to reflect that! Because winter is approaching, our minds in the parish office, and on the finance council, have turned to heating our two Churches and the rectory. We were able to lock in the price to pre-purchase our oil for the upcoming winter with Stiles Fuel. As you can imagine, the price has gone up significantly, nearly 100%, since last winter. The price of the oil this year was \$4.50 per gallon; the total cost to the parish this year was around \$24,000.00. Because of your generosity, we raised \$20,245.28 last year from our fuel collections, so we only needed to use around \$4,000 from the parish checking account. I want to thank you for your generosity to this parish, especially to the fuel collection; I am consistently amazed at the generosity of the people of this parish, which allows us to do great things for the Lord and for the people He has called us to serve. Thank you for your continued generosity, especially to the fuel collection! Let's keep in our prayers all those who are struggling to meet the rising cost of fuel.

We had a very successful first day of religious education last week! There is a positive spirit in our students, catechists, and volunteers. I know this will be a great year of learning more about our faith and growing in our knowledge and love of God.

Last Monday, I celebrated Mass for the first time at Mount Royal Academy North, the Catholic School in Lancaster, and I have agreed to celebrate Mass there every other Monday. Father Britto (the pastor in Lancaster) and I will be alternating, so that the school can have Mass offered there every week. Deacon Steve will join me when his schedule allows. Many of our parishioners attend that school as students, and many of our parishioners are teachers and administrators in that school. I am proud of the work being done to increase accessibility to Catholic education in our area, and I am proud of the good work being done in the name of the Lord at our Catholic schools. Let's keep them in our prayers!


