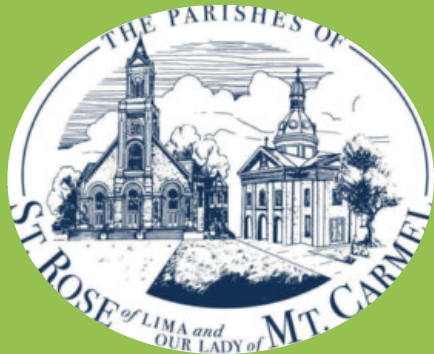

Your words, Lord, are Spirit and life. (Ps 19)

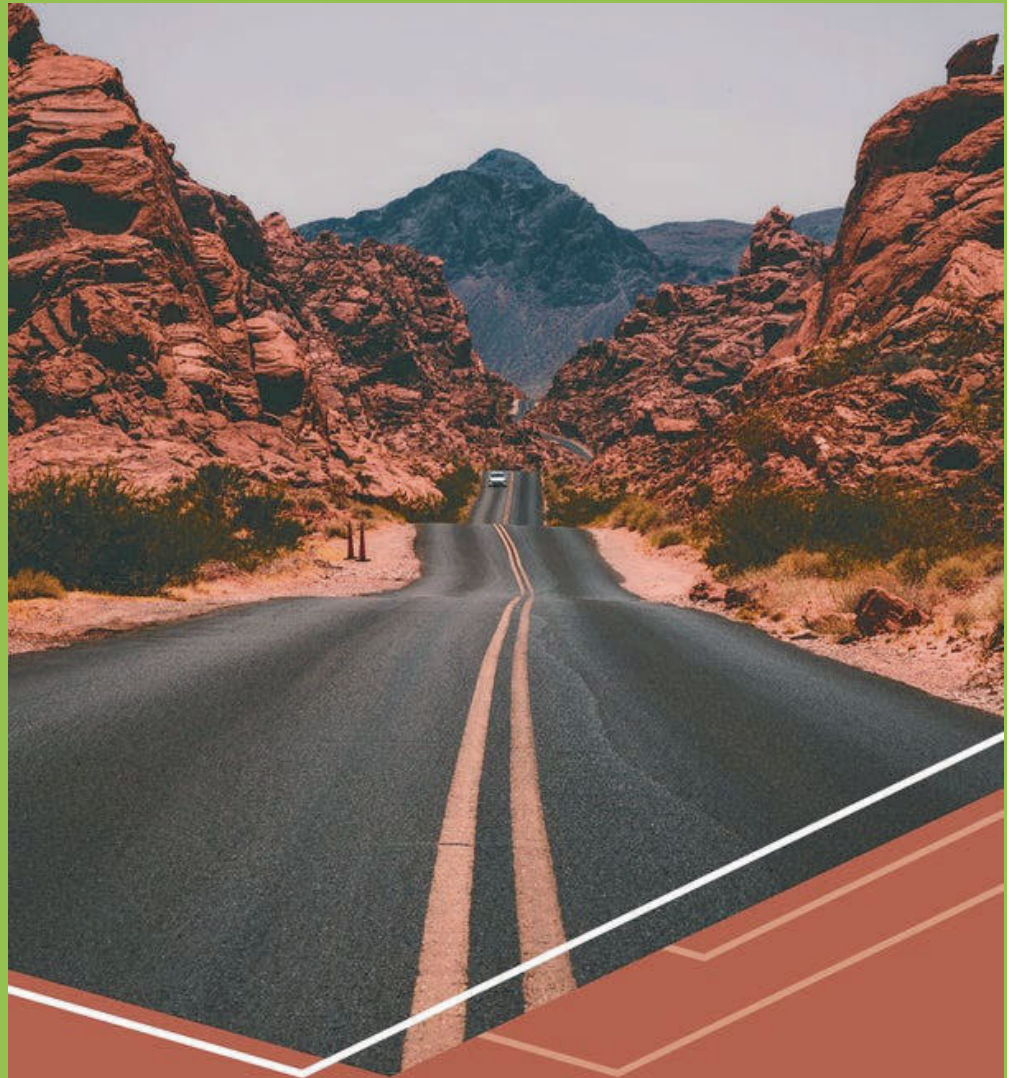
Second Reading:

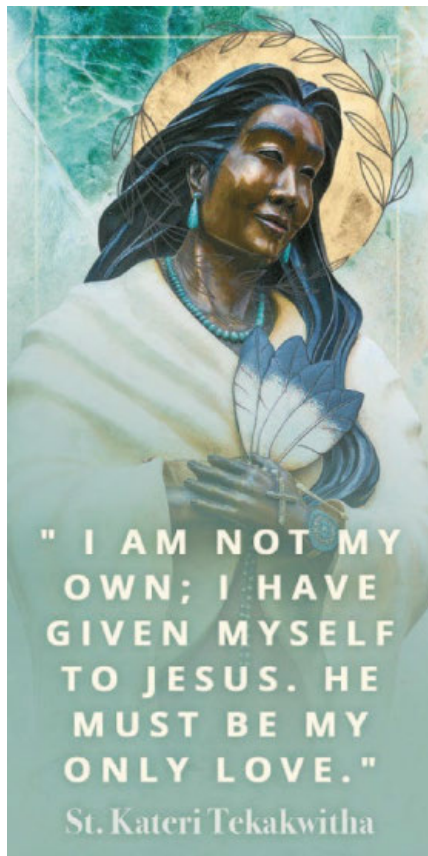

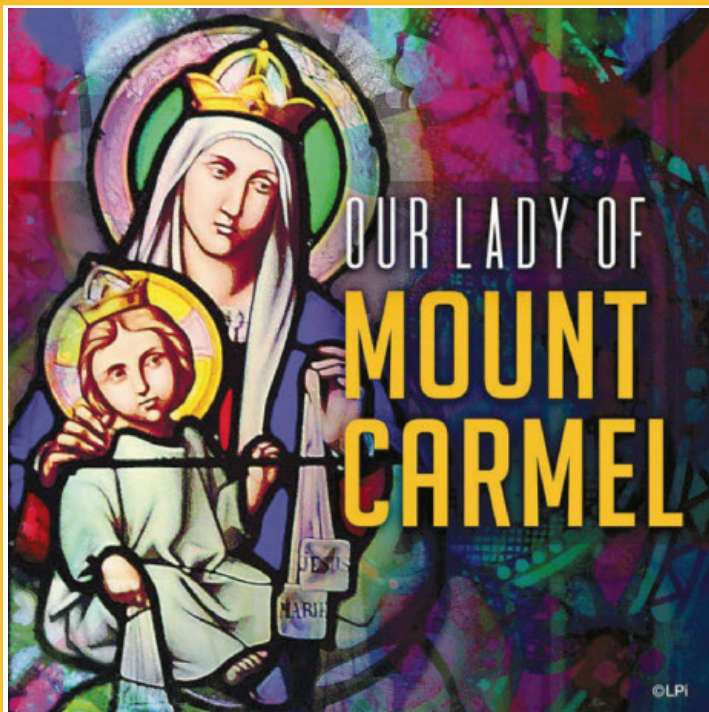
