

The major function of the Parish Pastoral Council is pastoral planning

1. Provide counsel and advice to the pastor in order to guide and determine the direction of the parish through effective pastoral planning.



- 2. Structure ways the parish may contribute to the mission of the Church.
- 3. Develop a plan for parish life by assessing needs and prioritizing goals and objectives. If a plan already exists, participate in its ongoing implementation, revision and regular assessment.
- 4. Work with commissions or committees to help further their work.
- 5. Exercise the role of servant leader.

Qualifications: abilities needed (skills, attitudes, understandings)

- 1. Have a call to the ministry of leadership.
- 2. Be capable of reflection, discernment, visioning, reaching consensus, and pastoral planning.
- 3. Possess a desire for spiritual growth in oneself and the parish.
- 4. Be enthusiastic about the future directions of the parish.
- 5. Have a willingness to listen well to others, to speak honestly, and to represent all members, not just a few.
- 6. Be willing to participate in decision-making and reaching conclusions through the process of consensus.
- 7. Have the ability to inspire and empower others and to delegate.
- 8. Possess a flexibility and openness with people and ideas.

Commitment:

- 1. A designated term of service: three years is common, but each parish may decide an appropriate length of service.
- 2. Preparation for and active participation in regularly scheduled and special meetings.
- 3. Recognition of the possible need for additional work between regular meetings. This could include:
 - Serving as a PPC liaison to a Coordinating Team to maintain ongoing relationships and effective communications.
 - · Serving as an officer of the PPC and attending Agenda meetings.

Preparation/Training Provided

- 1. Formation can be customized for each parish (Office for Parish Life Staff and PPC Facilitators are available).
- 2. Formation can be individualized to your PPC's specific area of need or interest.

Benefits of the Ministry Role:

- 1. To the PPC Member: the Parish Pastoral Councils provide a vehicle for parishioners to share their gifts and talents with the pastor and the community.
- 2. To the Parish Community: The parish will be reinvigorated as it carries out the hopes and dreams of its people, as written in the parish plan.

LISTEN LOVE, SACRIFICE, TRUST: HE SHOWED US THE WAY BY FR. MIKE SCHMITZ






