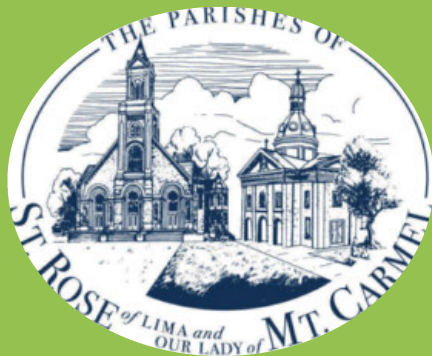

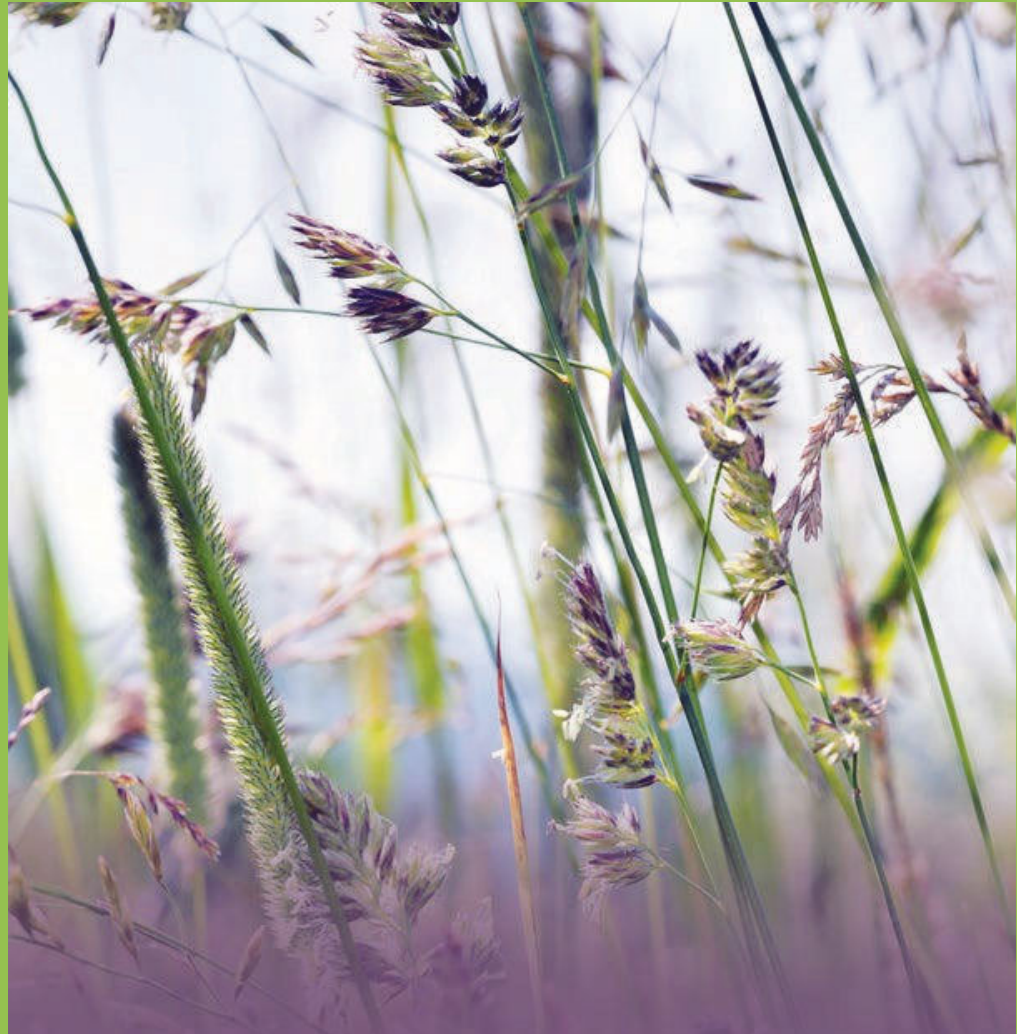

To be invited for service in this ministry of leadership, candidates must be: 18 years of age or older, a practicing Catholic, and a registered member of the parish who participates actively in parish life, especially Mass and the sacraments.

Once all names are submitted, the Joint Parish Council will review and pray over all of the candidates at the September meeting. At that time, recommendations will be made to the pastor who will make the final selection of our four new Council members (2 from OLMC and 2 from St. Rose).

Candidates should also be:

Prayerful: They are believers who attend liturgy regularly. Their actions are guided by Gospel values.

Pastoral: They are able to hear the needs of the people, to facilitate conversation around difficult issues, to follow-up with action, to reconcile differences, alleviate fears and offer comfort.

Representative: They have the ability to listen well to others, and represent all members.

Discerning: They are able to dialogue in an effort to reach consensus for the common good.

Prophetic: They respect the unique mission of the Church and are willing to challenge the status quo to initiate action to affirm or change it.

Empowering: They help create and sustain an environment that brings out the best in all resources of the parish community – human, financial and material. They work well with others.

Collaborative: They understand the challenges facing our parish and our diocese.

They are servant-leaders who share their talents generously and from an attitude of shared responsibility.

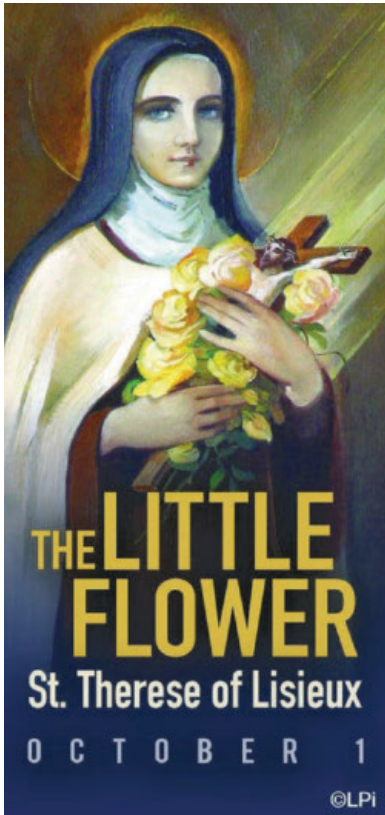
