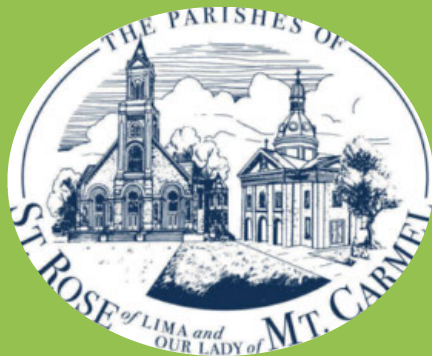

Dear Parish Family,

As fall begins and with school now in full swing, I want to update you on some things that have been happening around the parish.

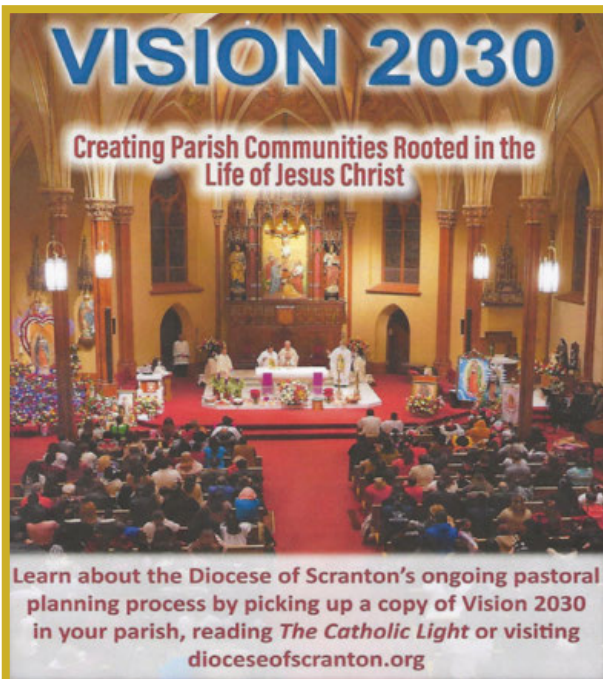
First, I want to thank everyone for adjusting to the new Mass schedule. I know change is not easy - but the good news is our overall Mass attendance numbers appear to be holding steady, albeit maybe with a very slight decrease! There is always room for you to invite your friends, neighbors and anyone who may not have been to Mass in a while. During the month of October, all parishes in the Diocese record their attendance numbers – but we will plan to continue recording our Mass attendance numbers through at least next April to help guide us with our planning efforts.

Second, I am happy to announce the new members of our joint Parish Pastoral Council. We received a number of self-nominations for the four positions (two from St. Rose and two from Our Lady of Mount Carmel). The current council had open discussion about the process and after prayer and discernment, a vote was taken to elect the new members. The two new members from St. Rose are James Kielar and Matt Colgan. The two new members from OLMC are Yvonne Gatto and Mike Shygelski. Their terms, as well as the terms for the rest of the council, will be discussed at a future meeting. The joint Parish Pastoral Council will be meeting regularly on the third Tuesday of each month, alternating between St. Rose Hall and the hall at OLMC.

Third, I would like to announce that we are currently planning to have our “Town Hall Meetings” in November. The exact dates/times will be coming in the near future. If you remember back in June, I indicated we asked the Diocesan Property & Risk Management to study all our facilities – looking at their structural integrity, design, interior finishes, mechanical systems and fire-safety code compliance. A lot of work has been put into the studies thus far, and hopefully this information will be another important “tool in our toolbox” as we plan for the coming decade and beyond. When we confirm the dates, I hope you will make every effort to join us. As always, continue to pray for our parishes and for the Diocese of Scranton as we embark on the Vision 2030 process.

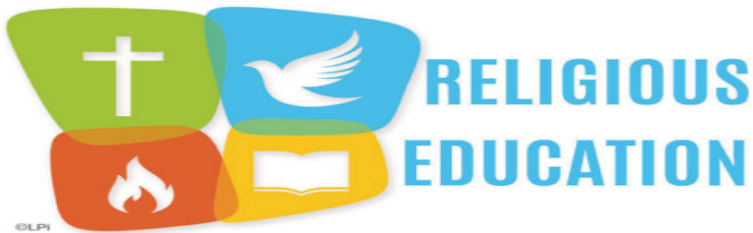

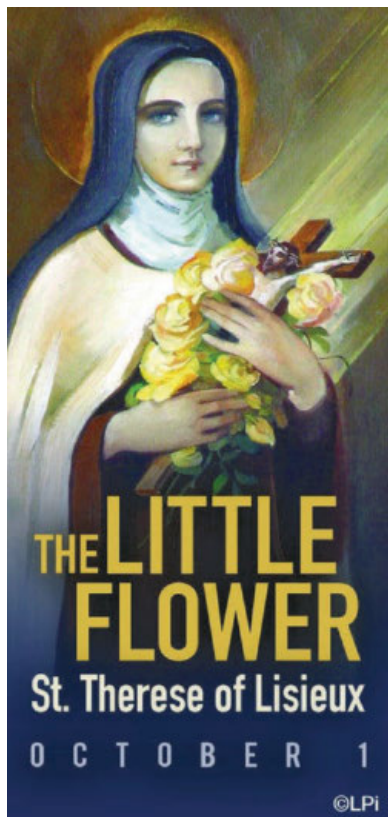

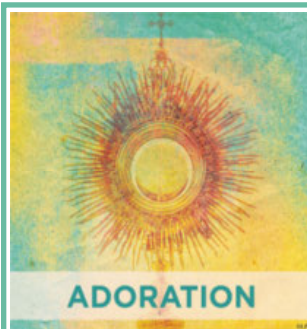
