

# THANK YOU FOR SUPPORTING THE RACE FOR RESIDENTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE MUSTARD SEED COMMUNITIES



Dear Parishioners,

At a time when the whole world has felt the unimaginable effects of the pandemic, the St. Thomas More Parish community rallied together to support the Mustard Seed Communities, and for that we are very grateful. With a loss of 2 million dollars in revenue from cancelled mission trips for two years, the Mustard Seed Communities is in great need

of funds to continue to provide critical care to its residents around the world. St. Thomas More created three teams to support their Race for the Residents fundraiser – STM Faith Team (prayer), STM Hope Team (exercise), and STM Charity Team (acts of kindness). Collectively we raised over \$30,000 thanks to the very generous donations from parishioners and their family friends. As part of STM Hope Team efforts, the Youth Group organized a YG Olympics and raised \$2,000. As part of STM Charity Team efforts, our religious education program helped to raise funds through sponsors for acts of kindness. Parishioners young and old committed themselves to helping those less fortunate.

St. Thomas More sent its first mission team in 2015 to help Mustard Seed Communities care for its residents who have been abandoned due to physical and/or mental disabilities. Our parish thoughtfully supported a mission team of 20 youth, clergy and chaperones for the following four years. The pandemic prevented us from sending in a team in 2020 and 2021. We kindly ask that you pray for a successful rollout of the vaccine to ensure the safety of the MSC residents and staff around the world. God willing, we are planning to send the next STM Mission Team to Jamaica from June 25, 2022 to July 2, 2022 to serve the Mustard Seed Communities.

On behalf of Fr. Paul, the Mustard Seed Communities staff, STM Hope Team Leaders (DHS Seniors) Lindsay Arrix and Georgia Sheehan, and myself, thank you as always for your commitment to serve the poorest of the poor. Your generosity is a true testament to your love, care and compassion for those in great need. May God bless you always.


