

FROM THE RECTORY

Our Children, Our Students and Our Youth

One of the hallmarks of St. Thomas More Parish are the many young families that make-up a large portion of our parish community. This year there will be close to 80 preschool students, 600+ grammar school students and 100+ high school students registered in our Faith Formation programs.

- Sept 26, kick-off of the 9th-12th grade Youth Ministry Program

At this time, I encourage all of our parents to register their children and youth in the appropriate ministry. Together we can assist them in personal growth, wisdom, love for God and neighbor. All of this begins with a proper love for self, aware that each of them is made in the image and likeness of God, who wants them to have the fullness of life and happiness, not only in this life but for all eternity.

LITURGICAL MINISTRIES UPDATE

As attendance expands at weekend celebration of the Mass, in line with the CDC, State and Diocesan Guidelines, we welcome back our liturgical ministers as they resume their participation in the liturgy of the word and distribution of Holy Communion.

On behalf of the St Thomas More Parish Community, we would like to thank all of our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Readers for their ongoing service.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

The Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) is a lay member of the faithful who has been appointed to help distribute Holy Communion when a sufficient number of ordinary ministers (clergy) are not present, available or when the celebrant (priest) has determined that pastoral need requires their help based on the size of congregation celebrating Mass. Parishioners are commissioned to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion after completing the mandated diocesan training. We are currently in need of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at all Masses.

Liturgy of the Word: Readers

When the Sacred Scriptures are read in the Church, God himself speaks to his people, and Christ, present in His word, proclaims the Gospel. The one who serves as a reader in Liturgy of the Word during Mass is the person designated to proclaim Sacred Scripture (with the exception of the Gospel). This person would also proclaim the psalm response (in the absence of a cantor), and the Universal Prayer or, as it is commonly known, the Prayer of the Faithful (in the absence of a deacon). Parishioners are trained and commissioned to serve as readers at Mass.
