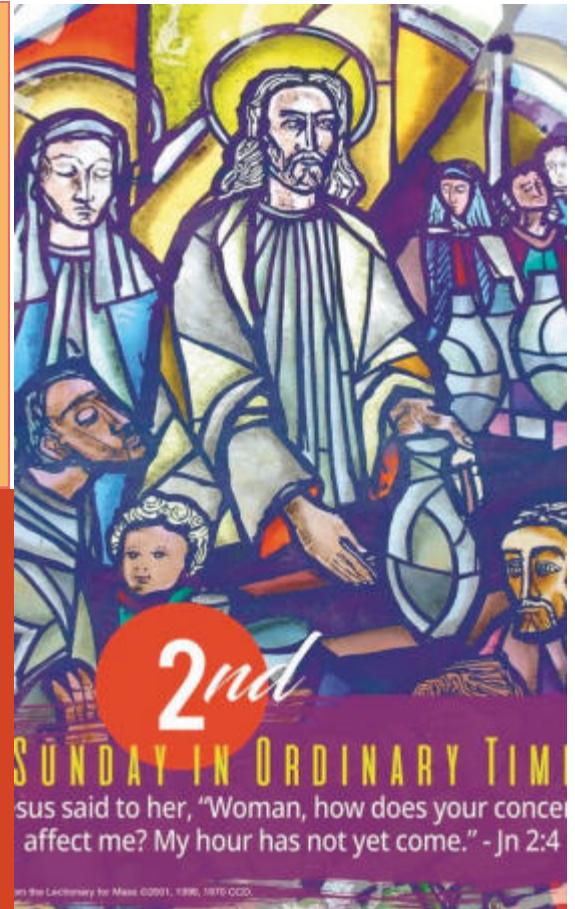

Mask-Wearing Protocols for Parishes
