

The Scholastic Achievement Committee of the Knights of Columbus Vermont State Council announce that they are taking applications for a Scholarship sponsored by them.

To qualify, an applicant must be a high school senior qualifying to graduate in June 2022 AND a son or daughter of a Knight of Columbus member (paternal or legally adopted) in good standing in a subordinate Council with the Vermont jurisdiction. 
