

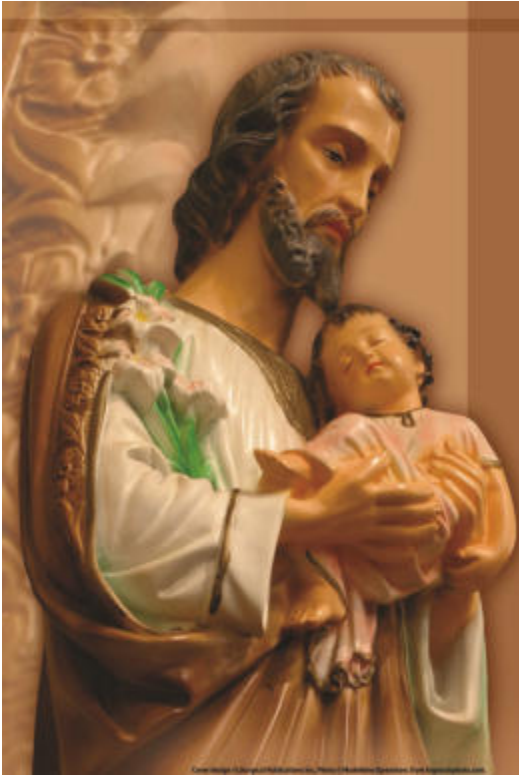

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS VERMONT STATE COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Scholastic Achievement Committee of the Knights of Columbus Vermont State Council announce that they are taking applications for a Scholarship sponsored by them.

To qualify, an applicant must be a high school senior qualifying to graduate in June 2022 AND a son or daughter of a Knight of Columbus member (paternal or legally adopted) in good standing in a subordinate Council with the Vermont jurisdiction. Sons and daughters of deceased members are also eligible if their father was in good standing at the time of his death. An applicant may be a member of the Knights of Columbus or a member of a Columbian Squires Circle, in the jurisdiction of Vermont and a high school senior qualifying to graduate in June 2022. Five \$ 1,000 scholarships will be awarded to assist recipients with their education at an accredited school or college of their choice.

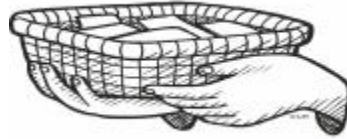

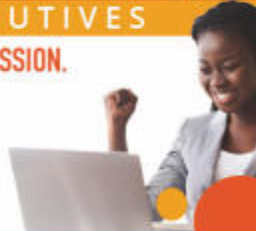
