

PASTOR'S CORNER

On the first Easter Sunday, the Lord proved his victory over death, darkness, evil, hatred, violence, and sin. On the first Easter Sunday, the light of the Resurrection pierced the darkness. The disci-

ples went from utter desolation to a joy beyond all joys. I pray that the grace of this Easter season will bring consolation and renewal to you, your family, our parish, our Church, and our world.

Fr. James and I will take turns getting some rest this week. Fr. James will be away at the beginning of the week, and I will be away at the end of the week. Please note the parish office is closed and there is no daily Mass on Monday.

We continue our strategic planning process this week with a meeting on Wednesday evening to discuss the due diligence that members of the committee have been undertaking. They have been assessing each facility based on criteria established by your input as well as the committee's. Eucharistic Revival

Over the history of the Church, we have seen many examples of saints who were famous for their connection to the Holy Eucharist. I have already written about St. Clare of Assisi and how here instinct was to bring out the Eucharist to ward off the invading army. Today I want to speak about the saint that was like a brother to her and inspired her: St. Francis of Assisi.

St. Francis is famous for his love for the poor, his own poverty and simplicity of life, his love for God's creation, and so much more. St. Francis was a deeply prayerful man and was deeply devoted to the Holy Eucharist. St. Francis wrote to all the friars under his care:

"O wonderful loftiness and stupendous dignity! O sublime humility! O humble sublimity! The Lord of the universe, God and Son of God, so humbles Himself that for our salvation He hides Himself under an ordinary piece of bread! Brothers, look at the humility of God and pour out your hearts before Him!"

Of course the humble St. Francis would pay special attention to the humility of God in the Eucharist. St. Francis also said that the things used for Mass (chalices, linens, etc.) should be clean, dignified, and well-maintained. He even urged his friars to pay special attention to that. Even in his pursuit of poverty and simplicity, he wanted to make sure the chapels in his friaries were clean, dignified and worthy of the Sacrifice of the Mass.

Did you know that St. Francis was never ordained a priest? He became a deacon so that he could preach at Mass, but he never felt worthy to be a priest and to hold the Eucharist in his hands. If St. Francis of Assisi was not worthy to be a priest and to hold the Eucharist in his hands, then this priest is in big trouble! However, God is merciful, and he called me, so I'm trusting that he is making up for what I lack.

Another thing St. Francis noted about the Eucharist was that we should love Christ present under the form of bread and wine and that should lead us to a greater love of Christ present in the poor and suffering.


SAFE ENVIRONMENT - INITIAL TRAINING SESSION
