#### SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

-Arrangements for all Baptisms must be made by contacting the Rectory. Godparents are required to be practicing Catholics, attending Mass regularly. First time parents must meet with a priest for instruction. All paperwork and payment (including sponsor certificates) are due at least 1 full week before the baptism.



-Matrimony arrangements should be made at least  $\underline{\mathbf{8}}$  **months** prior to the wedding date. Couples must attend designated Marriage Preparation Courses. Couples must meet with the parish priest before a wedding date can be scheduled. We do not celebrate weddings on Sundays.



#### **SPONSOR CERTIFICATES**

Sponsor Certificates are signed and sealed documents attesting to the fact that you are a <u>practicing Catholic</u> (going to Mass every week and living the Catholic faith). A Sponsor Certificate is required if you are being asked to be a sponsor for Confirmation or a godparent for Baptism. Please do not be offended if you can not receive a Sponsor Certificate because you are not living up to the requirements of being a sponsor.

#### **OUR CURRENT FINANCIAL POSITION**

At our June Town Hall meeting, I brought parishioners up-to-date on some of the important issues affecting the Church – the Pandemic, Renew/Rebuild, big ticket cost items and the current state of the Church's finances. With respect to our financial position, parishioner weekly donations have fallen well below prepandemic contribution levels. Without the receipt of federal government stimulus funding the Church would be running a deficit of approximately \$75,000 this fiscal year. For our 2021-2022 fiscal year beginning September 1, our projected deficit is estimated at \$150,000.

I know the pandemic has impacted the lives of many of our parishioners who may have contacted the virus, lost their jobs or have seen their salaries reduced. Our parishioners have been generous in the past with contributions to meet the goals of the Cardinal's Appeal and the Renew and Rebuild campaigns. Because of your yearly support for these campaigns, I have been reluctant to come forward to ask parishioners to increase their weekly contributions. Unfortunately, with the \$150,000 projected deficit I now need to ask parishioners to examine their personal finances to see if they can increase their weekly contributions. Currently, we have approximately 900 families who donate either using their weekly envelopes or contributing through online giving. If, on average, every family increased their contributions by \$3 per week, we would be able to cover this projected deficit.

# Holy Family Cardinal Basketball is Back !!!


