MANY HANDS MAKE FOR LIGHT WORK

Many of our fellow parishioners volunteer each week to serve at Mass as Lectors, Ushers and Eucharistic Ministers (EM's). The EM's will also volunteer to take the Eucharist to our home bound parishioners or to Catholic residents in our local nursing homes. We appreciate each and every one of them for this gift of their time and talent. But we could also use more help! The following is a brief description of what each role entails. If any of these are of interest and you would like to learn more, please contact the Parish Office for further information and training.

Lector: Reads the 1st and 2nd readings for your assigned Sunday and until we start having music, the Lector will also read the Responsorial Psalm and the Intercessions.

Ushers: Arrives early to help open the building and set up for Mass. Makes sure all parishioners and particularly visitors are welcomed and seated comfortably. Most important, at the end of Mass, places the offertory gifts in the safe.

Eucharistic Ministers - Some training required. On your assigned day, assist the Pastor with the distribution of the Eucharistic. In addition, you can volunteer to take the Eucharistic to our homebound parishioners or to the Catholic residents in nursing homes.

While not a formal role, we could also use Greeters at each Mass. Someone who likes to smile and welcome people as they enter the church building.

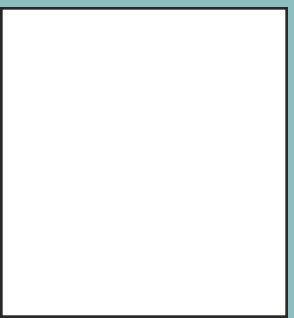
