Star Parishioner of the Month

**** Sara Applegarth ****

One word to describe Sara Applegarth would be **LEADER**. Her leadership at St. Mary's Star of the Sea (SOS) includes being one of the three parishioners along with George Radliffe and Sam Rizzo, who together with Fr. Bruce Byrolly founded the Star of the Sea Golden Hill Foundation in 1999. The purpose was to secure funding for out of the ordinary maintenance of the historic church and to apply for grants to help with this goal. Together with the France-Merrick Foundation, the church property has been maintained without extra help from the Parish. Sara was the one to take up the responsibility of nurturing Golden Hill after the passing of her husband, Hubert, whose family extends back to intersect with the Tubman's who built the first chapel in 1767.

Sara served as first chairman of the pastoral care committee and she was also very active on the cemetery committee. Sara was the landscape planner, church cleaner, flower arranger but most important of all she acted as the sacristan preparing the church and altar for the weekly Mass.

Sara knew the fine art of recruiting helpers included the offering of food, so she wisely planned monthly meetings at local dining establishments. Sara was successful in recruiting and training attendees of these meetings who went on to serve the church at SOS for over 20 years. There are some military recruiters who could learn some lessons from her!

For many years, Star of the Sea hosted a monthly breakfast fellowship after their Mass on Sunday mornings. It was a labor of love from all and Sara could be counted on for her homemade sausages that she provided each and every time.

Sara, we thank you, for your leadership, your devotion and above all your love and care of the prettiest church in Dorchester County, St. Mary Star of the Sea.
