RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASS GUIDELINES

Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12 students in Maryland memo from the Diocese of Wilmington Catholic Education Department:

All students, staff, and visitors in Catholic schools, religious education programs, and CYM sports and events will be required to wear masks indoors beginning September 1.

Masks are to be fitted tightly on the face, especially over the nose, under the chin, and no gaps on the cheeks.
