**Shore Rivers Grant Information**

**General description:** Saint Mary's will be partnering with ShoreRivers, a non-profit organization focused on protecting and restoring our local waterways, on a Chesapeake Bay Trust (CBT) Green Streets, Green Jobs, Green Towns grant. In the coming year, ShoreRivers will work with parish council members and congregants of Saint Mary Refuge of Sinners church to create a conceptual plan for the church's property near Ham-brooks Bay. The final conceptual plan will showcase possible stormwater management and habitat preservation projects on the property, combining the vision of church community members with new best practices for stewarding the land.

Once the conceptual plan is finished in spring of 2022, we will pursue the next grant in the Green Streets, Green Jobs, Green Towns program to complete a fully-engineered design for projects and then implement those projects on the church grounds. Once completed, these projects could serve a variety of purposes, including treating runoff, preventing pollution, and preserving important habitat for native animals like the bald eagle.

**From the CBT website:** This [G3] program supports design projects, financing strategies, and/or implementation of green street projects. This program also supports white papers on innovative ideas for green infrastructure and charrettes to plan and vision a green street project with developers, citizens, planners, and other key stakeholders.

**Information about ShoreRivers:** ShoreRivers is a 501 © 3 nonprofit organization which protects and restores Eastern Shore waterways through science-based advocacy, restoration, and education.

**Parish Council will meet with Shore Rivers on November 11th and we will then schedule the date for parishioner input. We expect this to take place after the 9:00am Mass. You will receive plenty of notice for this very important gathering. Stay tuned!**

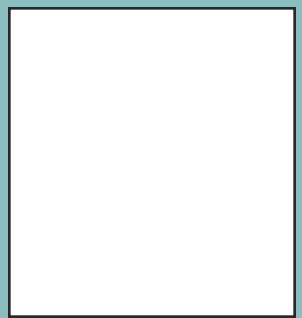
