### **LONGEST NIGHT**

The Christmas season is marked by expressions of joy, excitement, and happiness. It's a time for family to gather and for churches to worship pointing to the hope that is found in the coming of the Christ child.

However, this time of joy and expectation can often overshadow the pain and hurt many experience during this season, when the world's merriment puts their grief and sorrow in stark relief.

One of the greatest acts of pastoral care in the Advent season is to offer a service known as a *Service of the Longest Night*. It's a worship service scheduled around the winter solstice (the longest night of the calendar year) and it just happens to fall on or around December 21<sup>st</sup> every year. It provides an opportunity for folks to express their adverse feelings and memories and be comforted by the community.

Two longest night services will be offered this year in Cambridge on Tuesday, December 21<sup>st</sup>. One will be held at Immanuel UCC at 6:30 and another at Zion UMC at 7:00 pm. These are both ecumenical services and all are welcome.


