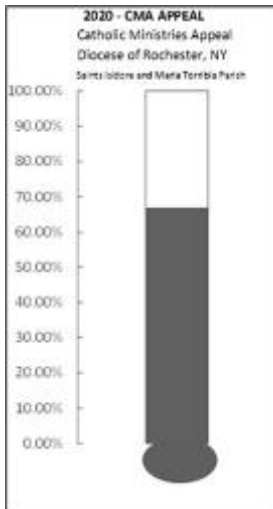

PENTECOST SUNDAY

Today we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon Mary and the Apostles gathered in the Upper Room awaiting the Promise of the Advocate, as Jesus had foretold at the Last Supper. He came upon them in *tongues of fire* and they began to *speak in tongues*. The pilgrims gathering in Jerusalem heard this *speaking in tongues*, which turned out to be

the languages of those pilgrims, *devout Jews from every nation under heaven*, who had come to Jerusalem for the Great Feast. This got their attention and ultimately led to their coming to know Jesus. The tongues were not just for show, or to set those gathered in the Upper Room as apart or somehow different like magicians or such. No, the Holy Spirit



was filling them and empowering them to carry out Jesus' command to *preach the Gospel to all nations*.



What about you and me? Preach the Gospel? St. Francis of Assisi in the 1200s told his Friars, *Preach the Gospel at all times, but only use words when necessary*. In other words, our

example is what people look at first, it is what they notice. Then come the words. Our example builds a bridge over which we can meet the other and find a common ground where a dialogue can happen, and questions be asked by them about our belief, our reason for our hope, what lies behind our commitment to our worship. They may even want to imitate us by coming with us to Mass and discovering what we have found in the Good Shepherd who invites us and them to His Holy Table, to give us spiritual nourishment, His very Body and Blood, and all because we were willing to be His Hands and Heart for others in our world.
