ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA
 This Saturday, June 13th, is the feast of Saint Anthony of Padua. He was born Fernando Martins de Bulhões; 15 August 1195 in Portugal and became an Augustinian priest in 1210. He joined the Franciscans in 1220. He was a great preacher, known as the *Hammer of Heretics!*. He died in 1231 at age 35. He is pictured often as holding the Christ Child to symbolize Anthony's childlike simplicity before God. He holds the lily to symbolize his purity of heart. To look at him in this picture he seems very meek and mild, hardly a "Hammer of Heretics". But in the pulpit he was a forceful instrument of God in speaking the Truth through his preaching. St. Francis of Assisi recognized this gift in him. Anthony became a member of the Order of Friars Minor, who followed the Rule of Saint Francis of Assisi. St. Anthony's life: Born 1195 and Died 1231. St. Francis of Assisi's life: Born 1181/82 - 1226. So St. Anthony and St. Francis were contemporaries. St. Anthony is the patron saint of many things, including lost articles. This may have come about because of his preaching to Heretics, 'lost souls'; he was their patron of sorts. Perhaps that is how he became the patron saint of lost articles as well. I am not sure.

A WORD OF HOPE from Deacon Dave LaFortune:

I am writing this reflection on the last day of May, 2020 to be inserted in the June 7th bulletin. I pray that by the time you read this, the rioting and unimaginable violence that has swept through our country will finally have come to an end.

Due to the isolation and quarantine we have all been experiencing, it strikes me that my words might run a little counter to world events. When St. Paul was isolated, he wrote letters designed to teach lessons and give hope. He reminded the early Christians that their faith wasn't about an easy life and a care-free existence. Paul told them that Jesus came to save them for the purpose and promise of eternal life which was much bigger than any current discomfort or pain that they might be experiencing.

“Brothers and sisters, rejoice. Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you.” In today’s gospel Jesus told all of us to “keep our eye on the prize”

“For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him.”

Faith is about experiencing hardship and knowing that, because of Jesus, the unimaginable is possible and real. Because of Jesus we know that peace and joy come with faith in God and hope for eternal life. We all have had events in our lives that stretched our confidence in the promise of hope. Seventeen years ago, this month, I was about to begin what would define my life to come. I was beginning full time ministry in the Diocese and was in the second year of diaconate training when the words of St. Paul and Jesus himself were put to the test in my life. My wife was diagnosed with stage 4 cancer and was given little hope. We just kept moving forward. We were blessed to have examples of hope, personified in good and holy people, all around us. We made it through and she is alive to this day, and healthy.

When darkness seems so dark that you feel you will never see light again hold on to the most important message of our day.

“Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace”

Be at peace and I cannot wait to see you in church soon!
