UNDERSTANDING AND LOVING THE MASS - Fr. Pat

In Eucharistic Prayer I there is a section that strikes me whenever I pray it. It is worth reflecting on with you:

Remember, Lord, your servants, N. and N. and all gathered here, whose faith and devotion are known to You. For them, we offer You this sacrifice of praise, or they offer it for themselves and all who are dear to them: for the redemption of their souls, in hope of health and well-being, and paying their homage to You, the eternal God, living and true.

It strikes me when it says, *They offer it for themselves and all who are dear to them*

Just think how at every Mass you bring to God prayers not just for your own needs but for those *who are dear to you*. You don't have to make a list of names, you don't have to tell God the details of the problems for yourself or them. God sees your heart and knows whose needs and what love you carry. Just being in His presence to offer all you are to Him is a prayer in itself. It includes *all who are dear to you*.

Then this prayer reads on:

for the redemption of their souls, in hope of health and well-being.

Isn't that what we all bring to the Lord when we come to Mass? We want salvation and we also want good health and peace of mind, body and soul (well-being). Again, this is the fruit of the Mass, from experiencing that touch of Jesus who comes to us in the Sacred Mystery of Holy Mass, and enters our Mind, Heart and Soul in Holy Communion.

In this Communion He helps us to unite with Him in that particular grace expressed in the next lines of this Prayer:

and paying homage to You, the eternal God, living and true.

Our union with Our Lord is when we best express our homage with our *eternal God, living and true*. For just before Communion we say, *Lord, I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof. But only say the Word, and my soul shall be healed*. The Lord brings healing to our souls in Holy Communion, a healing that helps us pay homage to our God, a homage not just of lip service, but of becoming His Hands and His Heart to all we meet, esp. our suffering brothers and sisters. In this time of isolation in these pandemic days, and of unrest in our country, let us be a people of hope and peace...for all. In the words of the Prayer of St. Francis, *Lord, make me an Instrument of Your Peace!*

THIS FRIDAY, JUNE 19TH, IS THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS . WHEN OUR LORD APPEARED TO ST. MARGARET MARY ALACOQUE, HE GAVE HER THESE 12 PROMISES TO THOSE WHO MADE THE NINE FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTIONS:

1. I WILL GIVE THEM ALL THE GRACES NECESSARY FOR THEIR STATE OF LIFE.
2. I WILL GIVE PEACE IN THEIR FAMILIES
3. I WILL CONSOLE THEM IN ALL THEIR TROUBLES.
4. THEY SHALL FIND IN MY HEART AN ASSURED REFUGE DURING LIFE AND ESPECIALLY AT THE HOUR OF DEATH.
5. I WILL POUR ABUNDANT BLESSINGS ON ALL THEIR UNDERTAKINGS.
6. SINNERS SHALL FIND IN MY HEART THE SOURCE AND INFINITE OCEAN OF MERCY.
7. TEPID SOULS SHALL BECOME FERVENT.
8. FERVENT SOULS SHALL SPEEDILY RISE TO GREAT PERFECTION.
9. I WILL BLESS THE HOMES IN WHICH THE IMAGE OF MY SACRED HEART SHALL BE EXPOSED AND HONORED.
10. I WILL GIVE TO PRIESTS THE POWER TO TOUCH THE MOST HARDENED HEARTS.
11. THOSE WHO PROPAGATE THIS DEVOTION SHALL HAVE THEIR NAME WRITTEN IN MY HEART, AND IT SHALL NEVER BE EFFACED.
12. THE ALL-POWERFUL LOVE OF MY HEART WILL GRANT TO ALL THOSE WHO SHALL RECEIVE COMMUNION ON THE FIRST FRIDAY OF NINE CONSECUTIVE MONTHS THE GRACE OF FINAL REPENTANCE; THEY SHALL NOT DIE UNDER MY DISPLEASURE, NOR WITHOUT RECEIVING THE SACRAMENTS; MY HEART SHALL BE THEIR ASSURED REFUGE AT THE LAST HOUR.

This devotion consists in attending Holy Mass and receiving Holy Communion in reparation for those who do not receive Our Lord, who do not love Him and who wound Him by their sinful lives.
