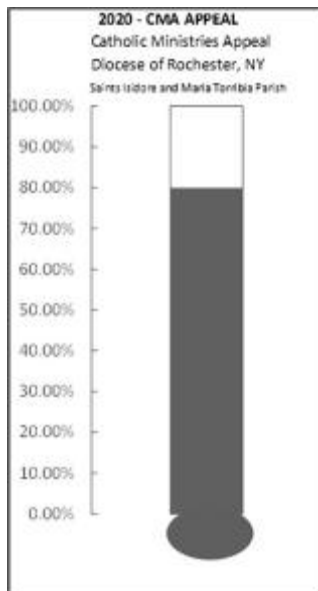

**SAINT OF THE WEEK - SAINT BONAVENTURE**



**Feastday: Wed July 15th  
Saint Bonaventure,  
Bishop and Doctor of  
the Church**

**Born: 1221  
Died: 1274**

**He was named *Giovanni* at birth. He became sick, and his mother, upon meeting St. Francis of Assis, asked the saint to pray for the child. After praying for him, as they parted company, St. Francis gave a part-**

**ing with, *Bona ventura*, translated, *Have a good journey* So Giovanni became Nicknamed, *Bonaventure*, and that is how we know him to this day. He eventually became a follower of St. Francis and joined the Franciscan Order, OFM. He became a priest, and a bishop. He was very learned, and was noted for his preaching and teaching. Since his teaching was declared to be free of any error, the Church eventually declared him a Doctor of the Church and also a Saint.**
