**THE GIFT OF IGNORANCE**

In our first reading today God appears to Solomon in a dream and effectively tells Solomon that he can have absolutely anything he wants! Solomon responds that he would appreciate it if God would make him wise enough to make decisions that would be consistent with what is right and what is wrong. Remember that Solomon was basically a teenager when he became king. Every teen I ever knew, including myself, knows everything. Solomon is no different. He knows that he doesn't know everything. Isn't that refreshing! The leader of God's people knows that he needs God's help when it comes to dispensing justice fairly. Would that we all knew that knowledge actually means knowing that we are ignorant! God gave us all the gift of ignorance in order to ensure that we listen to his message of truth and justice. God created us out of goodness, joy and decency. God created us to take care of each other with care and concern. God created us in order for us to help God take the evils of the world and turn them into blessings. Satan must be very frustrated sometimes. Evil exists only when we forget that we have a God given responsibility to root it out. "Going along to get along" is the manifestation of sin. Making the right choice is not always easy, but it is no less Godly. God's people are not allowed to sit back and let others make all the decisions absent God's goodness. God's people look like God because they look to God for the roadmap of living faith. The world we live in today is often scary, illicit and confusing. In the midst of all of this our job is to look toward God and away from what is the easy. When Christ walked upon the earth, he often had it rough. He was surrounded by doubters and cynics, but he never stopped. Christ spoke about what was right even when he knew what would happen to him for having done so. Jesus was not trying to win a popularity contest. He wanted to win a just population. A population of believers who loved each other because their God had shown the how to do so. I pray today that we might all be able to take a lesson from a teenage king and search for justice and goodness knowing we are not able to do either without the help of the one who created us.

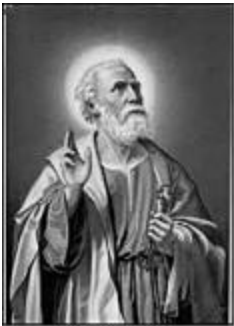

**TIME TO WAKE UP!  
TIME TO M-O-O-O-VE IT!!**



Due to the reorganization in light of the CORONA VIRUS, we need help in these areas:

**CASH COUNTERS:** We have teams who count once a month and this is done for all three churches at St. Catherine's on Monday mornings. Some teams begin 8:30am, others 9am, Call the office for more information, 607-359-2115.

**USHERS & SANITIZERS:** the Ushers are the people who open up church, greet you at church, hand out bulletins, invite you at Communion when to leave your pew and step out into the aisle, then the same at end of Mass. They also help oversee putting your money into the collection basket and getting it into the tamper proof bag.

**SANITIZERS:** stay after Mass to wipe down the pews sat in with spray and any other areas used. It takes about twenty minutes, depending on how many volunteer.

**CALLING PARISHIONERS:** Many of our parishioners do not have access to our Website, or can't get out to Mass. So our only means of Communication is by phone. We need people to call them from home. We would provide you with a phone list and you call regularly to keep in touch and make them aware of events.
