A Reflection By Deacon Dave LaFortune

Last week I spoke about imagining. I spoke about stretching our minds to see the hand of God in all we do, even the mundane in our daily lives. Today God speaks to us about not only acknowledging that it is his hand holding the rudder, but accepting that it is our responsibility to make sure that the rudder is maintained and strong.



Today we are challenged, to love each other, but also to take seriously the job of reminding others about what is right and what is wrong. The readings are challenging us to act, not to turn a blind eye to evil. We cannot fulfil our Christian responsibility simply by saying we love each other, we must love each other enough to point out when their behavior is inconsistent and not in line with what our Lord directs us to do. Christ did not come to simply show us "The Way", he came to tell us we had a role to play in order to show others "The Way". We cannot claim we are Christians and then fold our arms and wait for our reward. Our reward comes when we do not sit idly by ignoring the evil that we know is against the decency and integrity that Christ proclaimed.

Our world is complicated, our responsibility isn't. When we see wrong, we must point it out. When we witness evil, we must cry out for goodness. When we know that others are speaking against the will of God, we must correct them. If others ignore the will of God we may not be able to change their minds, but if we do not try we may be no better than they are. As followers of Christ we may not always agree, but we are called to be honest and consistent with the teachings of the Christ and the love of his father.

As followers of Christ we must be Christ for others. Christ came to love and we can do no less. We should raise our voices without screaming, but none-the-less, we must raise them. Silence is not an option.

CASH COUNTERS: We have teams who count once a month and this is done for all three churches at St. Catherine's on

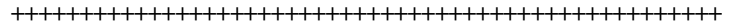
Monday mornings. Some teams begin 8:30am, others 9am, Call the office for more information, 607-359-2115.

USHERS & SANITIZERS: the Ushers are the people who open up church, greet you at church, hand out bulletins, invite you at Communion when to leave your pew and step out into the aisle, then the same at end of Mass. They also help oversee putting your money into the collection basket and getting it into the tamper proof bag.

SANITIZERS: stay after Mass to wipe down the pews sat in with spray and any other areas used. It takes about twenty minutes, depending on how many volunteer.

CALLING PARISHIONERS: Many of our parishioners do not have access to our Website, or can't get out to Mass. So our only means of Communication is by phone. We need people to call them from home. We would provide you with a phone list and you call regularly to keep in touch and make them aware of events.
