Due to the recent reorganization we need help in these areas:

CASH COUNTERS: We have teams who count once a month and this is done for all three churches at St. Catherine's on Monday mornings. Some teams begin 8:30am, others 9am, Call the office for more information, 607-359-2115.

USHERS & SANITIZERS: the Ushers are the people who open up church, greet you at church, hand out bulletins, invite you at Communion when to leave your pew and step out into the aisle, then the same at end of Mass. They also help oversee putting your money into the collection basket and getting it into the tamper proof bag.

SANITIZERS: stay after Mass to wipe down the pews sat in with spray and any other areas used. It takes about twenty minutes, depending on how many volunteer.

CALLING PARISHIONERS: Many of our parishioners do not have access to our Website, or can't get out to Mass. So our only means of Communication is by phone. We need people to call them from home. We would provide you with a phone list and you call regularly to keep in touch and make them aware of events.

THE BLESSING OF PETS



Last weekend we had a total of three hours...one hour at each church...for the Blessing of Pets. We had a nice turnout at each site...and the weather cooperated in that it did not rain, even though it was overcast and a bit on the cool side. After the Blessing each pet was presented a Certificate of Blessing with its' Name, the Date, the Location, and both Fr. Pat's and Deacon Dave's names. Also, two pictures on it...one a puppy and a bunny cuddling, then St. Francis and the tamed Wolf of Gubbio. Tradition says that the people of Gubbio, a village in Italy, were always under attack by a wolf. St. Francis was walking

nearby, so they asked for his prayers. He not only promised prayer, but went into the woods, found the wolf, prayed over it and suddenly it became so tame the people adopted it as their pet. They housed it, fed it daily. It would scare off threatening animals, and be affectionate to the people. It lived a number of years with them in peace, then died. Thus, St. Francis became the Patron Saint of Animals...especially Pets. One highlight was when some neighbors in Addison came not with a Pet, but some Doggie Treats to pass



out. You should have seen the dogs go wild...with Joy! I kiddingly asked if I could have one...but figured the dogs would gang up on me and wrestled me to the ground to get the treat from me!!! LOL. A few of the folks were farmers...and now I have a date to go bless some cows...and pigs, goats, donkeys and chickens! Better get my boots. I love it! - Fr. Pat
