Due to the recent reorganization we need help in these areas:

CASH COUNTERS: We have teams who count once a month and this is done for all three churches at St. Catherine's on Monday mornings. Some teams begin 8:30am, others 9am, Call the office for more information, 607-359-2115.

USHERS & SANITIZERS: the Ushers are the people who open up church, greet you at church, hand out bulletins, invite you at Communion when to leave your pew and step out into the aisle, then the same at end of Mass. They also help oversee putting your money into the collection basket and getting it into the tamper proof bag.

SANITIZERS: stay after Mass to wipe down the pews sat in with spray and any other areas used. It takes about twenty minutes, depending on how many volunteer.

CALLING PARISHIONERS: Many of our parishioners do not have access to our Website, or can't get out to Mass. So our only means of Communication is by phone. We need people to call them from home. We would provide you with a phone list and you call regularly to keep in touch and make them aware of events.

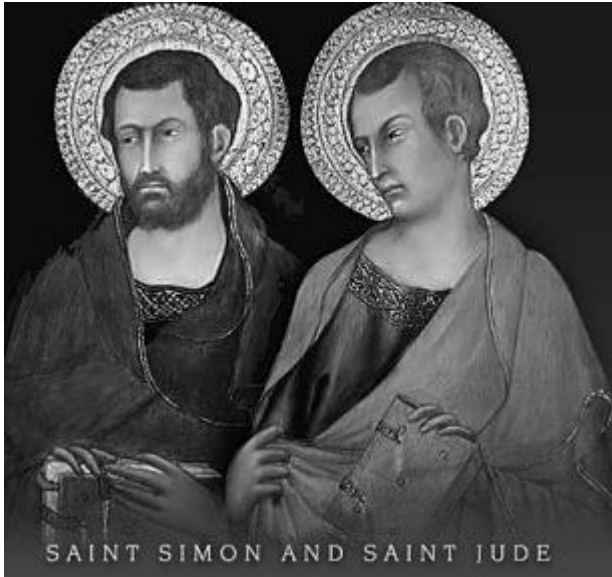

SAINTS OF THE WEEK - SIMON AND JUDE

JUDE THADDEUS, Apostle, (not Judas Iscariot), died around 65 A.D. of Martyrdom, He was axed to death. St. Jude is the Patron Saint of Lost Causes, Desperate Situations, Hospitals.

SIMON THE ZEALOT, Apostle, died with St. Jude. St. Simon was sawed in half for his Martyrdom. He is the Patron Saint of Curriers, Sawyers and Tanners.

UNDERSTANDING AND LOVING THE MASS - Fr. Pat

From time to time I like to choose for one of the options for the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass one titled, Eucharistic Prayer For Use In Various Needs IV: Jesus Who Went About Doing Good. Here in part is an excerpt from this Eucharistic Prayer which I offer for your reflection and prayer:

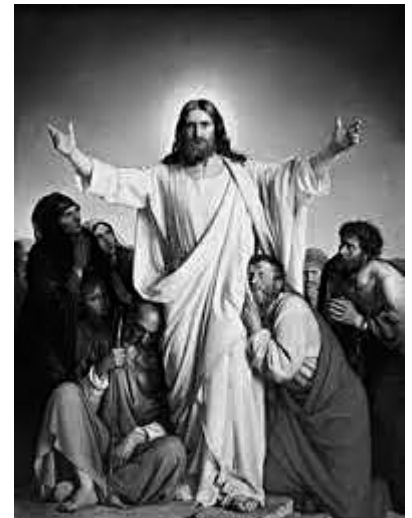


It begins with an excerpt from the Preface: *For you have given us Jesus Christ, your Son, as our Lord and Redeemer. He always showed compassion for children and for the poor, for the sick and for sinners, and he became a neighbor to the oppressed and the afflicted*".

Then the Eucharistic Prayer continues after the Consecration: *"Open our eyes to the needs of our brothers and sisters; inspire in us words and actions to comfort those who labor and are burdened. Make us serve them truly, after the example of Christ and at his command. And may your Church stand as a living witness to truth and freedom, to peace and justice, that all people may be raised up to a new hope"*.

A New Hope! This is what Mass is all about...leaving with a New Hope, Jesus, our Bread of Life, whom we have received into our hearts and souls through Word and Sacrament. We cling to Him like those in the picture below...as He holds His arms as if to say, *Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy-laden, and I will give you rest!* The labor we have may include our anxieties and fears, and all the burdens we face in these days of this Pandemic, of politics, of the Church Sex-Abuse Scandal and just so many other things that turn our world upside down and put our culture at odds with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Here we are in this month of Respect Life, and there is so much Lack of Respect For Life around us! It seems Hopeless!

But don't despair. Jesus is our Hope! Cling to Him!! Like the above prayer said: *Inspire in us words and actions to comfort those who labor and are heavy burdened!* In the words of St. Francis: *Lord, make me and Instrument of Your Peace!*
