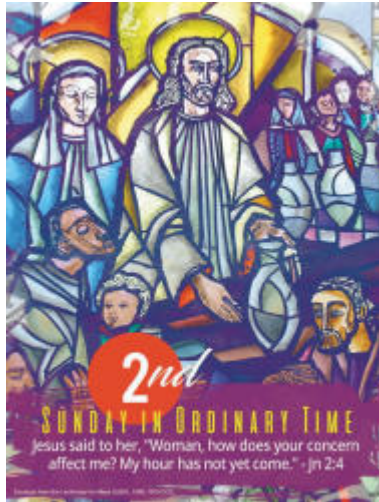

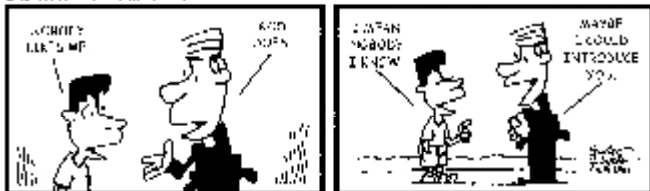

This Prayer Service involves a large Host taken from the Tabernacle and placed in the Monstrance, to be seen and adored. "Monstrance" means "to show", and this devotion "shows" Jesus to us.

MAKING THE ORDINARY 'EXTRAORDINARY'
- A Reflection By Father Pat

Here we are in the Liturgical Season known as 'Ordinary Time'. The vestments at Mass are green. The Christmas decorations in church and outside of church are all put away. The Church says about this time: *Besides the times of the year that have their own distinctive character, there remains in the yearly cycle thirty-three or thirty-four weeks in which no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ itself is honored in its fullness, especially on Sundays. This period is known as Ordinary Time (Universal Norms, 43)*

Webster's Dictionary defines 'Extraordinary' as *Going beyond what is usual, regular, or customary OR exceptional to a very marked extent OR employed for or sent on a special function or service.*

When I consider both the Church's view of Ordinary Time and Webster's Definition, I think about the Saints. When I was a young boy in Catholic school and learned about the saints, I tended to put them on a pedestal and see them as perfect people. Now, they often were on pedestals as statues in church or in stained glass windows. They always wore a halo, which I again interpreted as being perfect.

But when I entered the seminary, I began to learn more about the saints' lives, and saw their struggles and came to realize they weren't perfect. They were sinners like me, imperfect, who kept on trying... not trying to sin, but to be more like Jesus, and ask for His grace and help. They received such grace and their holiness was really that of Jesus living in their hearts, which made them act like Him. It made ordinary people live 'extraordinary' lives of holiness.

This is our invitation and our vocation. The Christmas season may be over...but not its' lessons. Let's not put away the spiritual growth it gave us. Let's live in this Ordinary Time in an Extraordinary Way... like the Saints, like Jesus. You can do it...because Jesus has come to you to make you into not a Superhuman or Perfect Person...but a Saint. Trust Him, and follow Him. Amen!

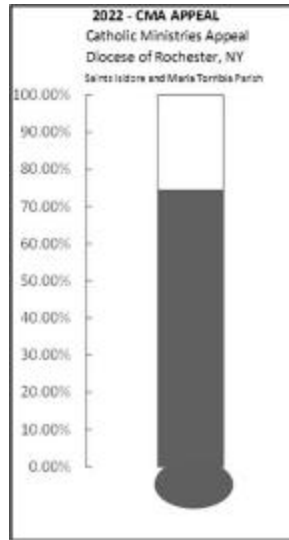


Father Romane St. Vil, will speak at all the Masses this weekend. Maryknoll is the popular name
