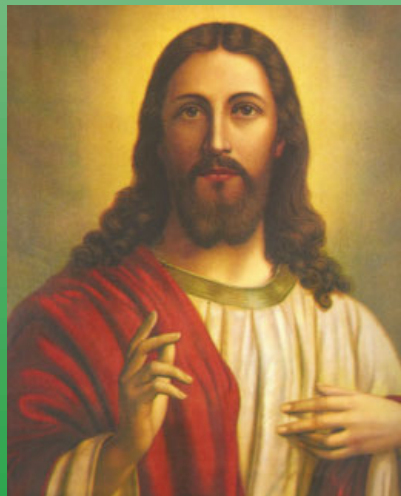

Administrator's Message

Dear Parishioners,

As highlighted in our recent town hall meetings, our church has some urgent repair needs that have been overdue for three years. These repairs are essential to ensure the safety and integrity of our church. The needs include:

- Replacing the asphalt roofing on the side aisles, nave, and sacristy
- Replacing gutters and downspouts on both levels
- Removing the existing bell tower and infilling the deck
- Restoring stained-glass windows

The estimated cost for these repairs is between \$1.2 and \$1.6 million.

Funding the Repairs

Fortunately, we have approximately \$2.5 million in our savings account, which we can use to cover these expenses. However, to further support the repairs and to avoid depleting our savings completely, we have decided to participate in the diocesan Beacon of Faith Campaign.

Beacon of Faith Campaign/Parish Capital Campaign

Our parish goal for the Beacon of Faith Campaign is \$513,000, which will be split 50/50 between our parish and the diocese. However, to address the identified parish repair needs, we have decided to expand our campaign goal to \$1.2 million. For this goal, any amount up to \$513,000 will be split in half between our parish and the diocese, and 100% of any amount over \$513,000 will go to our parish.

Based on this agreement with the diocese, if we raise \$1.2 million, the diocese will receive \$256,000, and our parish will receive \$943,500. After deducting the \$61,000 owed for the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal, our parish will be left with \$882,000.

The commitment period for this campaign is between 3-5 years. Based on our current number of 300 parishioners, this works out to approximately \$2.74 per day per parishioner over the 5-year period. Consequently, if every parishioner sacrificed \$2.74 per day, over a five-year period or less, we would joyfully realize this goal.

Capital Campaign Partnership

We have partnered with a professional company to help us run the capital campaign. The cost of this partnership is \$70,000. The Diocese recommended the company we're working with because our goal is higher than what they typically handle. Other parishes with similar goals have used this company or similar ones.

2025 Annual Catholic Appeal

I would like to apologize for the delay in sending out the 2025 Annual Catholic Appeal letters. We'll ensure that they reach you soon. Our parish goal for this year's ACA is \$61,000.

Finally, I understand that times are tough, and I don't want to place an undue burden on anyone. However, I encourage each of you to prayerfully consider what you can contribute to the well-being of our parish. It's not just about the amount we give, but also the love and commitment behind it.

Catholic Parish Initiatives Raffle Update

A big THANK YOU goes out to parishioners for their participation in the Catholic Parish Initiatives Raffle. A total of 841 tickets were purchased and, consequently, \$10, 512.50 was raised for our Parish.

IMPORTANTLY, we have received \$1,000 in a grant back from the Raffle and will be conducting our own "mini-raffle" at the Spaghetti Dinner on October 5, 2025. There will be 3 prizes: one \$500 prize and two \$250 prizes. Winners will be drawn randomly from the list of ticket purchases. No further action is necessary! If you are unable to attend the dinner, it is not an issue. The winners will be contacted and American Express gift cards distributed.

Finally, the Parish Council has recommended that parishioners be engaged in determining how the funds that were raised through the raffle be used. To this end, parishioners will be asked for their input on priorities. Stay tuned for details!

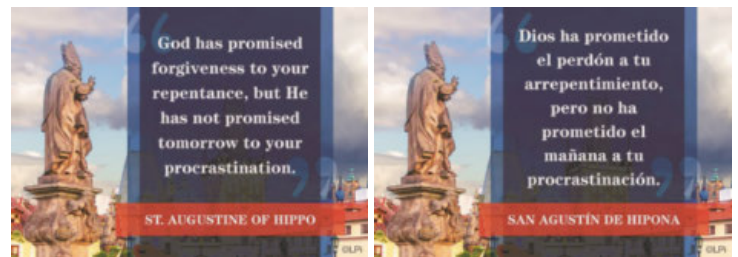

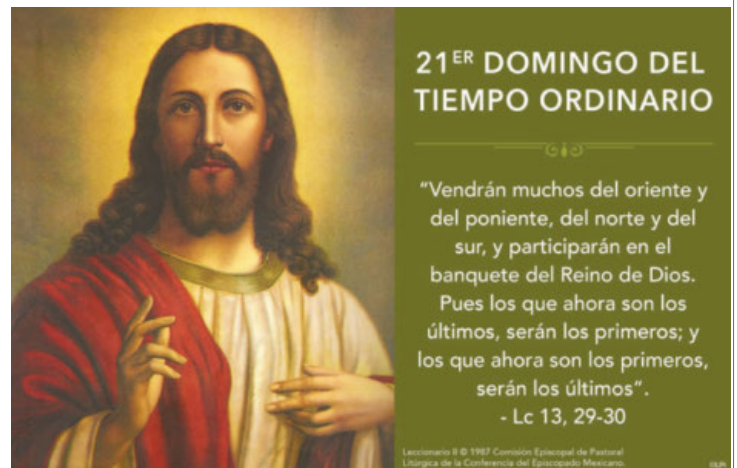

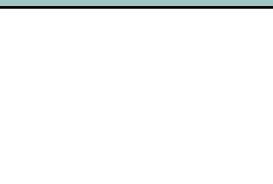
