A WORD FROM FR. TOM -

We celebrate Catechetical Sunday this weekend. What is a catechist? It would be easy to define a catchiest as someone who passes on facts. Also, we could see catechists as those who teach our faith formation only about ages 5-16. However, faith formation is from baptism until death. Most parishes only focus on the school age group.

A catechist is a witness to Christ. To be a witness means to know Christ as Lord and Savior. What we are called to pass on to others, whether it be to the young or adult, is Jesus. If we think of our faith that way, we are all teachers. Parents promise at the child's baptism to raise them in the Catholic Faith. A couple at their wedding promises that if they have children, they will raise any children in the faith. At Confirmation, we are empowered by the Spirit to witness to Jesus and in the Eucharist, we receive him. As adults, young, middle age and older, we have the responsibility to keep growing in the faith: to know Jesus deeper and to learn more about the Scripture and the doctrine of the Church.

One of the big concerns of every pastor is the disconnect between the youth in faith formation and the weekly obligation to attend Mass. I miss them and their parents too. As a community of faith, we lack the enthusiasm of the youth and the presence of our brothers and sisters, their parents. To be honest, I would rather have them at Mass than in a classroom if time is the issue.

One idea I have been considering is to possibly change our focus from teaching to discipleship formation. What would that mean? It would mean a return to a model of the early church in which people gave their lives to Christ and then they learned about him. Look at the story of St Paul in the Acts of the Apostles. Baptism followed this so that people would know who they were baptized into. This is a dream that will take years to happen, if at all. But, as the angel said to Mary, "All things are possible with God.

A heartfelt thank you to the catechists of our three parishes and to Maria and Paula for their willingness to lead our parishes in this important work. May God bless their ministry.

Weekly Reconciliation

With the new Mass schedule, the weekly schedule of Reconciliation has changed. At Immaculate Conception, Reconciliation is now offered at 5 pm on Saturday. If I am celebrating all weekend Masses, then it will be after the 6 pm Mass. At St. Joseph's, Reconciliation is at 3 pm on Saturday and Monday at 5 pm. At Our Lady of Grace, it is by appointment for now.

Eucharistic Reflection

I have been reflecting on how we can renew ourselves our belief and in our love of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. One thing I think gets in all of our way is our busy-ness. When I listen to a client whose life is filled with stress, anxiety, worry or teetering on the edge of burnout, our sessions begin to focus on self-care. Taking time for oneself is vital.

Taking time for Jesus is vital, too. How can we grow in our love of Him if we do not spend time with him? Just as we need to the light of the sun to grow, we need sit in the light of the Son of God. Jesus is always present to us in the tabernacle. Consider spending some time with Him this week. Come to Adoration, or even just sit quietly in your own home, encountering God in the silence. If that feels like a challenge, start small – five minutes a day would be an open door to Christ in our heart.

Buildings and Grounds News

If you stop at St Joseph's, check out the new rug in the church, and the doors are almost finished; the next step is to repaint them. This week at OLG, the gathering space floor will be stripped and cleaned. At IC, we are awaiting the arrival of new church boilers. The parish center and rectory boilers have already been replaced. This was necessary due to their age.

Thank you for your continued support and a special **thank-you** to Tim Zakriski, the Facilities Director of all our parishes, for his hard work and for all those who have worked with him.

One last note

We have just seen another crisis in our world, the earthquake in Morocco. Please keep the people of Morocco, Maui, and every other place suffering from natural disasters in your prayers. People have asked about diocesan collections for different places. Right now none have been announced, but we will let you know. Also, you can always donate to Catholic Relief Services for world disasters and to Catholic Charities for US concerns. Make sure you note the place where you hope to see your donation go.
