Stewardship Gifts**

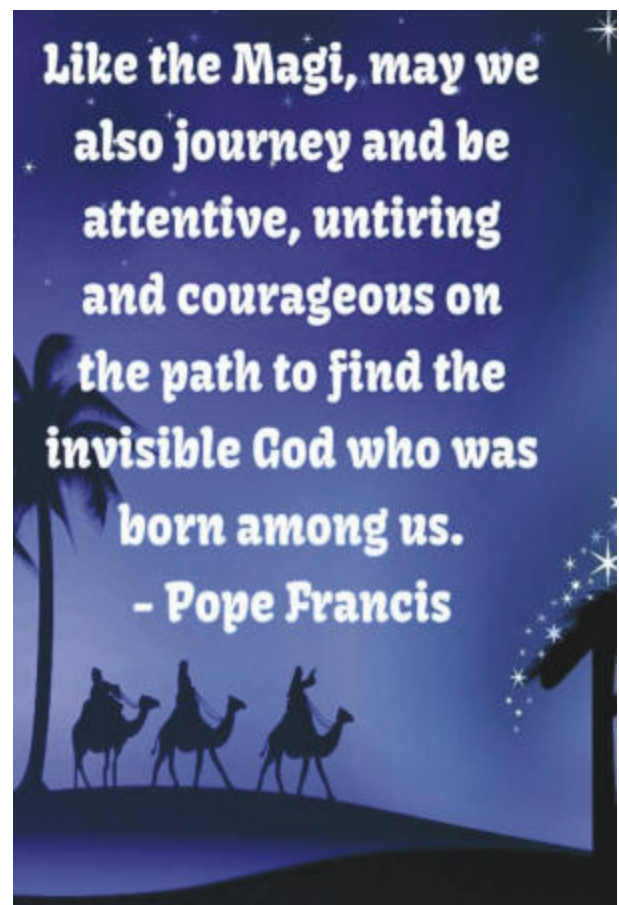
