



Eve is a co-founder of the North Country Mission of Hope, empowering the people of Nicaragua with sustainable programs as well as supporting local, national, and global areas impacted by disasters and poverty. Eve walks with people on the journeys of loneliness, loss, and end of life.

Eve was born and raised in the North Country. Married for 48 years to Patrick McGill, Clinton County Court Judge (Ret), she grew up in a very large family of twelve children experiencing food insecurity throughout her childhood. She has always felt called to serve through her faith. Eve highly recommends volunteering. "Step out of your comfort zone. It is a great way to meet new people and make lifelong friendships. Volunteering is a perfect way to give back; you get more than you give."



A native of West Chazy, Father Scott Seymour was born Sept. 9, 1970, son of the late Stanley Seymour and Loretta (Barcomb) Seymour. He graduated from Wadhams Hall Seminary-College, Ogdensburg, and Christ the King Seminary, East Aurora. He was ordained a priest, May 29, 1999 by Bishop Paul S. Loverde, Eleventh Bishop of Ogdensburg.

He was first assigned as Parochial Vicar at Notre Dame, Malone. In 2002, Parochial Vicar of St. Mary's Cathedral, Ogdensburg. In 2005 he became parish priest of St. Philip of Jesus, Willsboro and St. Joseph's, Essex. In 2009 named pastor of St. Alexander, Morrisonville and St. Joseph, Treadwells Mill. Soon, St. James, Cadyville, St. Joseph, Dannemora, Assumption of Mary, Redford became additional responsibilities.

After parish reconfigurations, Fr. Scott now serves as Pastor of St. Alexander, Morrisonville with St. Joseph Community Outreach Center, Treadwells Mill, St. Augustine, Peru with Mother Cabrini Shrine & St. Patrick's Oratory on the Patent Road, and St. James, Cadyville. Father Seymour is active in ministry with the Catholic Daughters of America serving as chaplain for Morrisonville and Peru Courts and is a past New York State chaplain. He also chaplains three Knights-of-Columbus Councils. An accomplished musician, Father Seymour has directed choirs for major diocesan events, as well as serving on many diocesan councils and committees.


